**TAXONOMIC NOTES** (following *Birds of the World: A Checklist* by J. Clements, 5<sup>th</sup> edition, 2000, plus updates).

- \* Green Heron (with chestnut neck) and Striated Heron (grey neck) are recent splits: the combined species was known as Green-backed Heron.
- ⌚ Whimbrel: brown-rumped American birds (Hudsonian Whimbrel) may in future be split from white-rumped Eurasian birds. This split is not yet official.
- ⌚ Yellow-chinned is the new name for Yellow-throated Spinetail (as the yellow is so inconspicuous).
- 👉 Chivi Vireo of South America is usually split from Red-eyed Vireo as it sings a two-note song, not three notes.
