

• **ANNOTATED BIRD SPECIES LIST.**

The numbers used in the species list below relate to the illustrations in Sousa's book All the Birds of Brazil. As noted in the Introduction to this report, this currently remains the only field guide to list all the bird species to be found in Brazil and is valuable for that reason alone. Clearly taxonomy has moved on since the book was published and we have tried to accommodate the changes in the following ways.

1. Where a species remains the same but the scientific and/or English name has changed we retain the Sousa reference but use the up to date nomenclature based upon the list in Birdlife's Avibase.

2. Where a split has occurred or a new species described we use the up to date nomenclature as in 1 but give the species a reference number in red to indicate that it is not described in the Sousa book.

Species names in English and those in capitals are endemic to Brazil

**14. 4 Greater Rhea (*Rhea americana*) Near-threatened**

Small parties seen in the Pantanal on 21,23 &25/10.

**14. 5 Solitary Tinamou \* (*Tinamus solitarius*) Near-threatened**

Heard at Intervalles on 5 & 6/11. Three singles seen early morning at Linhares on 22 /11.

**14. 10 Little Tinamou (*Crypturellus soui*)**

Single seen at Linhares on 22/11.

**16. 1 Brown Tinamou (*Crypturellus obsoletus*)**

A single bird observed at the nest in Intervalles on 5/11.

**16. 2 Undulated Tinamou (*Crypturellus undulatus*)**

Singles seen around Fazenda St. Teresa, Pantanal on 21 & 22/10.

**16. 10 Small-billed Tinamou (*Crypturellus parvirostris*)**

Heard only along the Agua Fria Rd, Chapada dos Guimaraes on 25/10.

**18. 1 Tataupa Tinamou (*Crypturellus tataupa*)**

Single seen crossing the track in remnant forest at Chapada dos Guimaraes on 26/10.

**18. 2 Red-winged Tinamou (*Rhynchotus rufescens*)**

A pair seen at Coxipo do Ouro near Chapada on 26/10 and on 8&9/10 at Canastra.

**18. 5 Spotted Nothura (*Nothura maculosa*)**

A few singles seen along the main track at Canastra on 8 & 9/11. Shy.

**26. 6 Brown Booby (*Sula leucogaster*)**

Common in the waters off Cananeia on 17 & 18/11.

**26. 8 Neotropic Cormorant (*Phalacrocorax brasilianus*)**

Common in the Pantanal and a few at Rio Cristalino.

**26. 9 Anhinga (*Anhinga anhinga*)**

Seen daily in small numbers in the Pantanal and at Rio Cristalino

**28. 1 Magnificent Frigatebird (*Fregata magnificens*)**

Small numbers off Ubatuba and at Cananeia in 17 & 18/11.

**28. 4 Cooi Heron (*Ardea cooi*)**

Seen daily in the Pantanal and once at Rio Cristalino.

**28. 5 Great Egret (*Ardea alba*)**

Seen daily in the Pantanal.

**28. 6 Snowy Egret (*Egretta thula*)**

Seen on 20,21 &23/10 in the Pantanal and at Cananeia on 17/11.

**28. 7 Little Blue Heron (*Egretta caerulea*)**

Seen along the Pixaim River at Faz. St Teresa on 20 & 24/10 and at Cananeia on 17 &18/11.

**28. 9 Striated Heron (*Butorides striatus*)**

Seen daily in the Pantanal, odd singles at Rio Cristalino and at Cananeia.

**30. 2 Cattle Egret (*Bibulous ibis*)**

Seen daily in the Pantanal and somewhat oddly at Rio Cristalino.

**30. 3 Whistling Heron (*Scrim sibilatrix*)**

Seen on 4 days out of 6 in the Pantanal.

**30. 4 Capped Heron (*Pilherodius pileatus*)**

Only seen twice. First in the Pantanal on 22/10 and then at Cananeia on 17 & 18/11.

30. 5 **Black-crowned Night-Heron** (*Nycticorax nycticorax*)  
Seen on 4 out of 6 dates in the Pantanal.
30. 7 **Rufescent Tiger-Heron** (*Tigrisoma lineatum*)  
Seen daily in the Pantanal and regularly at Rio Cristalino.
32. 1 **Zigzag Heron** (*Zebrilus undulatus*)  
We heard 5 or 5 separate birds calling, apparently holding territories, downstream from the lodge at Rio Cristalino. One seen well at Rio Cristalino on 29/10.
32. 4 **Wood Stork** (*Mycteria americana*)  
Common, seen in numbers each day in the Pantanal.
32. 5 **Maguari Stork** (*Ciconia maguari*)  
Uncommon, a single bird from the Transpantiniera on 20/10.
32. 6 **Jabiru** (*Jabiru mycteria*)  
Common, seen daily in the Pantanal.
32. 7 **Plumbeous Ibis** (*Theristicus caerulescens*)  
Common, seen daily in the Pantanal.
32. 8 **Buff-necked Ibis** (*Theristicus caudatus*)  
Common, seen daily in the Pantanal.
32. 10 **Green Ibis** (*Mesembrinibis cayennensis*)  
Seen on 20 & 21/10 in the Pantanal and on 4 dates along the river at Rio Cristalino.
34. 1 **Bare-faced Ibis** (*Phimosus infuscatus*)  
Not common, seen in small numbers on 3 out of 6 dates in the Pantanal.
34. 4 **Roseate Spoonbill** (*Platatalea ajaja*)  
Not common, seen in small numbers on 3 out of 6 dates in the Pantanal.
34. 9 **Southern Screamer** (*Chauna torquata*)  
Seen daily in small numbers in the Pantanal.
36. 5 **White-faced Whistling-Duck** (*Dendrocygna viduata*)  
Seen on the Pixaiam River in the Pantanal on 21 & 22/10.
38. 7 **Brazilian Teal** (*Amazonetta brasiliensis*)  
Pairs seen on 20 & 24/10 in the Pantanal and at Folha Seca on 15/11.
38. 9 **Muscovy Duck** (*Cairina moschata*)  
Seen on 22 & 24/10 in the Pantanal and on the Riód Fransisco at Canastra (lower) on 8 & 9/11.
38. 10 **Brazilian Merganser** (*Mergus octosetaceus*) **Critically Endangered**  
A pair seen after a lot of searching at Canastra (lower) on 9/11.
40. 5 **King Vulture** (*Sarcoramphus papa*)  
Seen from the tower at RioCristalino on 28 & 29/10. Also at Canastra on 8/11.
40. 6 **Black Vulture** (*Coragyps atratus*)  
Common.
40. 7 **Turkey Vulture** (*Cathartes aura*)  
Common except at Rio Cristalino where absent.
40. 8 **Lesser Yellow-headed Vulture** (*Cathartes burrovianus*)  
In the Pantanal on 22/10 and around Sooretama on 23/11.
40. 9 **Greater Yellow-headed Vulture** (*Cathartes melambrotus*)  
A forest vulture seen only at Rio Cristalino on 29,30 & 31/10 and at Alta Floresta on 03/11.
40. 10 **White-tailed Kite** (*Elanus leucurus*)  
Seen only once at Chapada dos Guimaraes along the Agua Fria road on 25/10.
42. 2 **Swallow-tailed Kite** (*Elanoides forficatus*)  
This elegant raptor was common and seen throughout the trip at most locations.
42. 3 **Grey-headed Kite** (*Leptodon cayanensis*)  
A pair seen at PindobasIV on 25/11.
42. 4 **Hook-billed Kite** (*Chondrohierax uncinatus*)  
Seen in the Pantanal on 21/10 and at Sooretama on 21 & 23/11
42. 5 **Rufous-thighed Kite** (*Harpagus diodon*)  
Seen in the ouring rain at Intervaes on 6/11with a much better view at Linhares on 22/11.
42. 6 **Double-toothed Kite** (*Harpagus bidentatus*)  
Seen only once at Rio Cristalino on 29/10.

42. 7 **Plumbeous Kite** (*Ictinia plumbea*)  
Common seen throughout the trip.
42. 8 **Snail Kite** (*Rostrhamus sociabilis*)  
Seen daily in the Pantanal and at the open swampy area Linhares on 22/11.
42. 10 **Black-chested Buzzard-Eagle** (*Geranoaetus melanoleucus*)  
A single bird at Nova Lombardia on 20/11.
42. 11 **Mississippi Kite** (*Ictinia mississippiensis*)  
Several birds circling the town of Chapada dos Guimaraes on 24 & 25/10. Described by Birdlife as rare or accidental.
44. 1 **Bicoloured Hawk** (*Accipiter bicolor*)  
Only one record a single at Intervalles on 6/11.
44. 5 **White-tailed Hawk** (*Buteo albicaudatus*)  
A single bird in the Pantanal on 21/10.
44. 9 **Roadside Hawk** (*Buteo magnirostris*)  
In the Pantanal 22 & 23/10, Canastra NP 8 & 9/11, Sooretama 23/11
46. 1 **Grey Hawk** (*Asturina nitida*)  
At Linhares on 22/11.
46. 2 **Short-tailed Hawk** (*Buteo brachyurus*)  
A pair circling low around the Hotel Simon, Itatiaia on 14/11.
46. 4 **Mantled Hawk** (*Leucopternis polionota*) **Near-threatened**  
A couple of birds seen in the mist as the rain cleared from Carlos Botelho SP on 16/11.
46. 5 **WHITE-NECKED HAWK** (*Leucopternis lacernulata*) **Vulnerable**  
4 separate birds early morning at Linhares making characteristic short swooping flights along the trail from perch to perch. A couple of birds also seen at Sooretama on 23/11.
46. 10 **Black-collared Hawk** (*Busarellus nigricollis*)  
Seen on 4 dates out of 6 in the Pantanal.
48. 1 **Savanna Hawk** (*Buteogallus meridionalis*)  
Seen daily in the Pantanal and at Canastra NP on 8/11.
48. 3 **Great Black-Hawk** (*Buteogallus urubitinga*)  
Poor views of a bird soaring over the Pantanal on 22/10.
48. 7 **Harpy Eagle** (*Harpia harpyja*) **Near-threatened**  
A monster 10 month old immature bird near to its nest at Curruripa, Serra das Araras on 19/10.
48. 8 **Ornate Hawk-Eagle** (*Spizaetus ornatus*)  
Another soaring bird over the Pantanal on 22/10.
48. 9 **Black Hawk-Eagle** (*Spizaetus tyrannus*)  
A single bird perched close to the road as the rain cleared from Carlos Botelho SP on 16/11.
48. 10 **Crane Hawk** (*Geranoospiza caerulescens*)  
First seen in the Pantanal on 21/10 then Linhares on 22/11 and finally daily at Sooretama.
50. 4 **Laughing Falcon** (*Herpetotheres cachinnans*)  
A single bird along the track from Porto Joffre, Pantanal on 23/10
52. 1 **Black Caracara** (*Daptrius ater*)  
Only once, with 4 or 5 birds perched along the river at Rio Cristalino on 31/10
52. 3 **Yellow-headed Caracara** (*Milvago chimachima*)  
In the Pantanal on 20/10, Intervalles on 6/11, Canastra NP on 8 & 9/11, Cipo on 11/11
52. 5 **Crested Caracara** (*Caracara cheriway*)  
At Canastra NP on 8&9/11.
52. 8 **Bat Falcon** (*Falco ruficularis*)  
At Serra das Araras on 19/10, Rio Cristalino on 28 & 31/10 and at Alta Floresta on 3/11.
52. 9 **Aplomado Falcon** (*Falco femoralis*)  
Single bird perched by the roadside at Canastra (lower) on 8/11.
52. 12 **American Kestrel** (*Falco sparverius*)  
Only recorded at Canastra on 9/11.
52. 13 **Southern Caracara** (*Caracara plancus*)  
Seen daily in the Pantanal where common.
54. 2 **Spot-winged Wood-Quail** (*Odontophorus capueira*) **H**

Heard regularly at Intervalles and Itataiaia but they stayed in thick cover and never crossed a trail.

54. 5 **Speckled Chachalaca** (*Ortalis guttata*)  
A couple of birds seen along the river on 29/10.
54. 9 **Chaco Chachalaca** (*Ortalis canicollis*)  
Common in the Pantanal where it was seen daily.
56. 1 **Rusty-margined Guan** (*Penelope superciliaris*)  
A single bird walking along the trail at Linhares on 22/11.
56. 2 **Dusky-legged Guan** (*Penelope obscura*)  
At Intervalles on 5/11 and Itatiaia on 12/11.
56. 3 **Spix's Guan** (*Penelope jacquacu*)  
At Serra das Araras on 19/10 and at Rio Cristalino on the on Cacao & Taboca Trails 1&2/11.
56. 6 **CHESTNUT-BELLIED GUAN** (*Penelope ochrogaster*) **Endangered**  
Seen in the forest around Fazenda SantaTeresa in the Pantanal on 22&23/11.
56. 9 **Blue-throated Piping-Guan** (*Pipile cumanensis*)  
Fairly common along the Pixaim River in the Pantanal. Seen every day there on 21,22&23/10.
56. 10 **Bare-faced Curassow** (*Crax fasciolata*)  
Singles or pairs seen in the Pantanal along the banks of the Pixaim River 21,22&24/10 and at Porto Joffre.
56. 12 **Red-throated Piping-Guan** (*Pipile cujubi*)  
Seen along the river at Rio Cristalino on 28,29&31/10.
58. 2 **RED-BILLED CURASSOW** (*Crax blumenbachii*) **Endangered**  
A male, a pair and another single male seen as we traversed the many trails at Linhares on 22/11. Also heard and briefly seen at Sooretama on 23/11.
58. 4 **Razor-billed Curassow** (*Mitu tuberosa*)  
Singles seen at Rio Cristalino on the Cacao and Haffer Trails on 30&31/10
58. 7 **Hoatzin** (*Opisthocomus hoazin*)  
A couple of birds seen at Cigana Lagoon, Rio Cristalino on 31/10.
58. 8 **Limpkin** (*Aramus guaranauna*)  
Common in the Pantanal where they were seen daily and a couple of birds at the swamp in Linhares on 22/11.
58. 11 **DARK-WINGED TRUMPETER** (*Psophia viridis*)  
Fantastic views of a party of 10-12 birds within 15 minutes of stepping on to our first trail at Cristalino on 28/10. They were seen at the start of the New Trail giving their repertoire of gurgling and grunting noises as they passed by in open view only metres away. Also seen again near the lodge end of the Cacao trail on 01/11
60. 2 **Blackish Rail** (*Pardirallus nigricans*)  
Seen only once in a small marsh by the roadside in Canastra(lower ) on 9/11.
60. 6 **Ash-throated Crake** (*Porzana albicollis*)  
A pair taped in in the marsh along the entrance road to Sooretama on 23/11.
60. 9 **Grey-necked Wood-Rail** (*Aramides cajanea*)  
Singles seen daily in the Pantanal and at Intervalles on 7/11.
60. 11 **Slaty-breasted Wood-Rail** (*Aramides saracura*)  
Single bird crossing the trail at Intervalles on 6/11.
62. 4 **Red-and-white Crake** (*Laterallus leucopyrrhus*) **H**  
Heard on 12/11 at the small marsh near the turn-off to the road leading to Itataiaia.
62. 6 **Russet-crowned Crake** (*Anurolimnas viridis*)  
Taped out in the forest edge at Faz. St. Tereza on the Pixaim River in the Pantanal on 21/10.
64. 3 **Purple Gallinule** (*Porphyryula martinica*)  
Seen from the Transpantianiera Road on 24/10.
64. 8 **Sungrebe** (*Heliornis fulica*)  
A single bird on the Rio Cristalino riverbank on 1/11.
64. 9 **Sunbittern** (*Eurypyga helias*)

Singles seen almost daily from the Transpantaniera in the Pantanal and along the Pixaim River.

- 64. 10 Red-legged Seriema** (*Cariama cristata*)  
From the Transpantaniera on 24/10 as we headed to Pocone and at Canastra (lower) on 9/11.
- 66. 1 Wattled Jacana** (*Jacana jacana*)  
Common, seen daily in numbers in the Pantanal.
- 66. 4 Southern Lapwing** (*Vanellus chilensis*)  
Verry common in the Pantanal then seen at Canastra on 9/11 and at Linhares/Sooretama.
- 66. 5 Pied Lapwing** (*Vanellus cayanus*)  
Seen only once, two birds at Fazenda St Teresa, Pantanal on 21/10.
- 66. 8 Semi-palmated Plover** (*Chariadrius semipalmatus*)  
Scattered singles along the shore at Ilha do Cardosa, Cananeia on 17/11
- 68. 6 Lesser Yellowlegs** (*Tringa flavipes*)  
On the banks of the Pixaim River on 21/10
- 68. 8 Solitary Sandpiper** (*Tringa solitaria*)  
Along the banks of the Pixaim River at Faz. St Teresa, Pantanal on 21&22/10.
- 68. 9 Spotted Sandpiper** (*Actitis macularia*)  
A couple of singles in the mangroves around Ilha do Cardosa, Cananeia on 17/11
- 70. 4 White-rumped Sandpiper** (*Calidris fuscicollis*)  
Along the banks of the Pixaim River at Faz. St Teresa, Pantanal on 21/10.
- 72. 7 Black-necked Stilt** (*Himantopus mexicanus*)  
Common throughout the Pantanal.
- 74. 6 Kelp Gull** (*Larus dominicanus*)  
At Cananeia on 17&18/11.
- 76. 11 Royal Tern** (*Sterna maxima*)  
At Cananeia on 17&18/11.
- 78. 1 Large-billed Tern** (*Phaetusa simplex*)  
Seen over the marsh and along the river at Porto Joffre, Pantanal on 23/10.
- 78. 7 Black Skimmer** (*Rynchops niger*)  
Poor views of a single bird as it flew over the grounds at Faz.. St. Teresa, Pantanal on 23/10.
- 78. 8 Scaled Pigeon** (*Patagioenas speciosa*)  
Two birds seen along the entrance road to Sooretama on 23/11.
- 78. 9 Picazuro Pigeon** (*Patagioenas picazuro*)  
Widespread except at Cristalino. Seen in the Pantanal on 21/10, Canastra 9/11, Itatiaia 13/11
- 80. 1 Pale-vented Pigeon** (*Patagioenas cayennensis*)  
At Faz. St. Teresa in the Pantanal on 20&21/10.
- 80. 2 Ruddy Pigeon** (*Patagioenas subvinacea*)  
A couple of birds in the clearing at Cristalino on 1/11.
- 80. 3 Plumbeous Pigeon** (*Patagioenas plumbea*)  
At Serra das Araras 19/10, Intervalles 6/11, Itatiaia 12/11 and Nova Lombardia on 20&21/11.
- 80. 4 Eared Dove** (*Zenaida auriculata*)  
At Intervalles on 4,5&6/11 and Canastra 8/11.
- 80. 8 Ruddy Ground-Dove** (*Columbina talpacoti*)  
Common seen most days and locations throughout the trip except at Rio Cristalino
- 80. 9 Picui Ground-Dove** (*Columbina picui*)  
Seen daily in the Pantanal.
- 80. 10 Blue Ground-Dove** (*Claravis pretiosa*)  
Seen at Sooretama on 21&23/11.
- 82. 1 Long-tailed Ground-Dove** (*Uropelia campestris*)  
At Faz. St. Teresa in the Pantanal on 20,21&23/10.
- 82. 2 Scaled Dove** (*Columbina squammata*)  
Seen in the Pantanal on 20&23/10.

82. 3 **Grey-fronted Dove** (*Leptotila rufaxilla*)  
In a small patch of remnant forest below Chapada dos Guimaraes on
82. 4 **White-tipped Dove** (*Leptotila verreauxi*)  
Seen daily in the Pantanal.
82. 5 **Ruddy Quail-Dove** (*Geotrygon montana*)  
Great views of this shy species perched low at Intervalles (lower) on
- 17/11.
82. 8 **Blue-and-yellow Macaw** (*Ara ararauna*)  
A pair flying over the river at Cristalino on 28/10 was followed by several more sightings during our week here culminating in the extraordinary spectacle of 20-25 birds perched and flying around near the Cigana Lagoon on 31/10.
82. 9 **Scarlet Macaw** (*Ara macao*)  
The commonest macaw at Cristalino where we saw it daily Also seen at Alta Floresta 3/11.
82. 10 **Red-and-green Macaw** (*Ara chloropterus*)  
First seen on the road leading to Veu da Novia at Chapada dos Guimaraes on 25/10 and then at Cristalino on 27&28/10 and finally at Alta Floresta on 3/11.
84. 1 **Hyacinth Macaw** (*Anodorhynchus hyacinthinus*) **Endangered**  
These stunning macaws first seen from the Transpantiera just south of Faz. St. Teresa on 22/10 and later that day in the grounds of the hotel at Porto Joffre. The following afternoon as we travelled back up the road we turned off to Santa Isabelle Farm where we had the wonderful sight of up to 40 birds coming in to roost.
84. 4 **Golden-collared Macaw** (*Primolius auricollis*)  
Several birds perched in tree in the open country around Faz. St Teresa on 21/10.
84. 5 **Chestnut-fronted Macaw** (*Ara severa*)  
Described in the Lambert report as common we did not see these birds until 1/11, five days after our arrival at Cristalino. We did see them on each of the remaining 3 days including quite a number at the fish ponds at Alta Floresta where they did indeed seem common.
84. 6 **Red-bellied Macaw** (*Orthopsittica manilata*)  
Seen only at Alta Floresta where they appeared quite common.
84. 7 **Blue-winged Macaw** (*Primolius maracana*) **Vulnerable**  
Seen first above the waterfall at Chapada dos Guimaraes on 24/10 where several flew around the canyon before going to roost. Also seen at Linhares on 22/11
84. 8 **Red-shouldered Macaw** (*Diopsittaca nobilis*)  
Seen on our first day at Currupira Inn, Serra das Araras on 19/10.
86. 10 **GOLDEN-CAPPED PARAKEET** (*Aratinga auricapilla*) **Vulnerable**  
We stopped to refuel at a garage in the town of Piumhi about 50kms from Canastra when we saw a single bird perched on a TV aerial. Not the greatest way to see it but it gave great scope views to us and most of the garage staff and proved to be the only one we saw.
86. 1 **Blue-crowned Parakeet** (*Aratinga acuticaudata*)  
Several birds perched in trees in the open country around Faz. St Teresa on 21/10.
86. 2 **White-eyed Parakeet** (*Aratinga leucophthalmus*)  
Seen in the Pantanal on 23&24 /10 and at Chapada dos Guimaraes on
- 25/10.
86. 4 **Dusky-headed Parakeet** (*Aratinga weddellii*)  
Seen on our first day at Currupira Inn, Serra das Araras on 19/10.
- 88.05 **Crimson-bellied Parakeet** (*Pyrrhura perlata*)  
Poor views of a couple of these birds as they flew over a clearing on the New Trail on 28/10 while we searching for Long-billed Woodcreeper. (Note in ABOB this species is given the incorrect English name Pearly Parakeet)
86. 7 **Peach-fronted Parakeet** (*Aratinga aurea*)  
Seen in the Pantanal on 20,22/10 and in the national park at Chapada dos Guimaraes on 24/10.
- 86.8 **Nanday Parakeet** (*Nandayus nenday*)

- Several birds perched in trees in the open country around Faz. St Teresa on 22/10. (Note ABOB gives this species the English name Black-hooded Parakeet)
86. 9 **Monk Parakeet** (*Myiopsitta monachus*)  
Seen daily in the Pantanal.
88. 12 **HELLMAYR'S PARAKEET** (*Pyrrhura amazonum*)  
Several birds perched around the Serra at Cristalino on 1/11 and again at Alta Floresta on 3/11.
88. 3 **Maroon-bellied Parakeet\*** (*Pyrrhura frontalis*)  
Fairly common in S.E Brazil , seen at Intervalles on 6/11, daily at Itatiaia and Nova Lombardia.
88. 6 **White-eared Parakeet** (*Pyrrhura leucotis*)  
Seen daily in small numbers at Linhares and Sooretama from 21-23/11.
90. 1 **Blue-winged Parrotlet** (*Forpus xanthopterygius*)  
Several birds below the Casca D'Ante waterfall at Canastra on 9/11.
- 90 .4 **PLAIN PARAKEET** (*Brotogeris tirica*)  
Seen at Intervalles on 5&6/11 and was common at Linhares and Sooretama, particularly Linhares where there was a large flock present in the grounds outside the accomodation area.
- 90 .6 **Yellow-chevroned Parakeet** (*Brotogeris chiriri*)  
Seen daily in the Pantanal and at Canastra NP on 8&9/11.
- 90 .7 **Golden-winged Parakeet** (*Brotogeris chrysopterus*)  
A small flock in trees behind the fishpond at alta Floresta on 3/11.  
Not observed at Cristalino.
- 92 .6 **White-bellied Parrot** (*Pionites leucogaster*)  
Two birds perched seen from our second visit to the Tower at Cristalino on 2/11
- 92.7 **Pileated Parrot\*** (*Pionopsitta pileata*)  
Seen at Intervalles on 5&6/11
- 94.1 **Blue-headed Parrot** (*Pionus menstruus*)  
Where present appeared common, seen regularly at Rio Cristalino, Linhares and Sooretama.
- 94.2 **Scaly-headed Parrot\*** (*Pionus maximiliani*)  
Singles or pairs observed in the forest edge at Faz. St Teresa on 21/10, Itatiaia on 13/11 and at Linhares and Sooretama on 22&24/11.
- 94.4 **BLUE-BELLIED PARROT** (*Triclarina malachitacea*) **Vulnerable**  
Great views of this difficult to observe parrot at Intervalles On 4/11.
- 94.5 **Red-fan Parrot** (*Deropterus accipitrinus*)  
Several birds enjoying the early morning sun at Cristalino on 31/10 and from the Tower on 2/11.
- 96.4 **RED-BROWED PARROT** (*Amazona rhodocorytha*) **Endangered**  
After hearing these birds on several occasions and following much searching finally had great perched views of a pair along the Estrada Quirnao at Sooretama on 23/11
- 96.7 **Blue-fronted Parrot** (*Amazona aestiva*)  
Two birds in flight over the open grasslands around Faz. St Teresa on 21/10
- 96.8 **Orange-winged Parrot** (*Amazona amazonica*)  
This apparently widespread parrot failed to show up until Linhares and Sooretama on 22&23/11.
- 96.9 **Yellow-crowned Parrot** (*Amazona ochrocephala*)  
Seen only at Alta Floresta on 3/11.
- 96.10 **Mealy Parrot** (*Amazona farinosa*)  
Seen from the Tower at Cristalino on 29/10 and at Linhares and Sooretama on 22&23/11.
- 96.11 **KAWALL'S PARROT** (*Amazona kawalli*)  
A pair calling loudly flew low over us on the Rio Cristalino on 28/10.
- 98.1 **Dark-billed Cuckoo** (*Coccyzus melacoryphus*)  
Seen from the Transpantianiera as we returned to Pocone on 24/10 and at Canastra on 8/11.
98. 3 **Yellow-billed Cuckoo** (*Coccyzus americanus*)  
2 of these summer visitors in the same tree at Linhares on 22/11.

- 98. 6 Squirrel Cuckoo** (*Piaya cayana*)  
Fairly common with sightings, usually single birds, at Serra das Araras, in the forest at Chapada do Guimaraes, Intervalles, Canastra, Itatiaia, Linhares and Sooretama
- 98. 8 Little Cuckoo** (*Piaya minuta*)  
Seen in the Pantanal at Faz.St Teresa on 20/10 and at Cristalino on 28/10 on the New Trail.
- 98. 9 Smooth-billed Ani** (*Crotophaga ani*)  
Very common in open country everywhere.
- 98. 10 Greater Ani** (*Crotophaga major*)  
Also widespread and common but largely confined to forests and marsh.
- 100. 1 Guira Cuckoo** (*Guira guira*)  
Absent from Cristalino but common elsewhere seen throughout the trip, often in small parties.
- 102. 1 Tropical Screech-Owl** (*Megascops choliba*)  
In dense cover late afternoon 25/10 in a patch of remnant forest below Chapada dos Guimaraes.
- 102. 2 Variable Screech-Owl** (*Megascops atricapillus*) **H**  
Heard only once and then faintly from dense cover at dusk at Itatiaia on 13/11.
- 102. 5 Great Horned-Owl** (*Bubo virginianus*)  
Two birds at dusk on the Transpantania at the junction with the turn off to Santa Isabelle Farm on 23/10. Also heard in the wooded area above the falls at Canastra(upper) on 8/11.
- 102. 7 Tawny-browed Owl** (*Pulsatrix koenigswaldiana*)  
Thwarted by rain the first night we had great views of a pair taped out by the swimming pool at the Hotel Simon, Itatiaia on 1/11.
- 102. 8 Least Pygmy-Owl** (*Glaucidium minutissimum*)  
Seen in the daytime at Linhares being mobbed by other passerines on 22/11.
- 102. 9 Amazonian Pygmy-Owl** (*Glaucidium hardyi*) **H**  
Heard only at Cristalino on 29/10 on an unsuccessful owling foray.
- 104. 1 Burrowing Owl** (*Athene cunicularia*)  
Seen in open country, at Chapada dos Guimaraes on 24&25/10, Intervalles 4/11, Canastra 8&8/11, Sooretama 23/11.
- 104. 4 Mottled Owl** (*Ciccaba virgata*)  
Spotlit along the main track at Nova Lombardia on 20/11
- 104. 5 Rusty-barred Owl\*** (*Strix hylophila*)  
Disappointed initially with a lack of response at Intervalles and frustrated by horrible weather at Agulhas Negra after a ridiculously early start on 12/11 we were rewarded the following morning with wonderful views of a pair growling at(to?) each other.
- 104. 6 Striped Owl** (*Pseudoscops clamator*)  
Two birds spotlit perched on trees in farmland below Itatiaia on 12/11.
- 104. 8 Short-eared Owl** (*Asio flammeus*)  
Poor views of a bird flying at dusk at Canastra (upper) on 8/11.
- 106. 1 Great Potoo** (*Nyctibius grandis*)  
Great views of amazingly camouflaged male at its day time roost in the grounds on Faz.St. Teresa in the Pantanal on 22&24/10. Also seen on the Pixaim River after dark on 21/10. Two singles spotlit from the river as we travelled back to the lodge at Rio Cristalino after dark on 31/10
- 106. 2 Long-tailed Potoo** (*Nyctibius aethereus*) **H**  
Regrettably heard only in the distance on the Estrada Quiriniao trail at Sooretama on 21/11.
- 106. 3 Common Potoo** (*Nyctibius griseus*)  
One at its daytime roost in a patch of remnant forest below Chapada Dos Guimaraes on 25/10.
- 106. 6 Short-tailed Nighthawk** (*Lurocalis semitorquatus*)  
Seen over the river at dusk at Cristalino on 31/10 and at Intervalles on 5/11
- 106. 7 Least Nighthawk** (*Chordeiles pusillus*)



- Several birds seen flying over the road at dusk as we headed back to Cuiaba on 26/10; their trailing white edge to the wing clearly visible.
106. 10 **Lesser Nighthawk** (*Chordeiles acutipennis*)  
Flying over open country at Curruripa Inn, Serra das Araras on 19/10.
108. 2 **Band-tailed Nighthawk** (*Nyctiprogne leucopyga*)  
Seen from the canoe on the Pixaim River, Pantanal on 20&21/10.
108. 3 **Nacunda Nighthawk** (*Podager nacunda*)  
Common in the southern Pantanal approaching Porto Joffre on 22&23/10.
108. 4 **Pauraque** (*Nyctidromus albicollis*)  
Ubiquitous.
108. 5 **Ocellated Poorwill** (*Nyctiphrynus ocellatus*)  
Terrific views of 3 birds taped in at dusk at Nova Lombardia on 20/11.
108. 6 **Ladder-tailed Nightjar** (*Hydropsalis climacocerca*)  
Single birds seen perched by the river as they emerged from their roost at dusk at Cristalino on 28&31/10
108. 7 **Scissor-tailed Nightjar** (*Hydropsalis torquata*)  
A single bird sitting on a track after dark in farmland below Cipo on 10/11
108. 8 **Long-trained Nightjar\*** (*Macropsalis forcipata*)  
A single of this extraordinary species perched on the track and flying around at Intervalles on 4/11.
110. 6 **Spot-tailed Nightjar** (*Caprimulgus maculicaudus*)  
Great views of a single bird perched on a post after dark in farmland below Cipo on 10/11.
110. 8 **Blackish Nightjar** (*Caprimulgus nigrescens*)  
Birds roost on the roof of the accommodation units at Cristalino and are commonly seen at the Serra and Secret Garden.
112. 1 **White-collared Swift** (*Streptoprocne zonaris*)  
Fairly common at Intervalles, Canastra and Cipo.
112. 3 **Great Dusky Swift** (*Cypseloides senex*)  
Seen around the waterfalls at Chapada dos Guimaraes and Canastra (lower) on 24/10 & 9/11.
112. 4 **Sooty Swift** (*Cypseloides fumigatus*)  
Seen in the company of the preceding species at Canastra (lower) on 9/11.
112. 7 **Grey-rumped Swift** (*Chaetura cinereiventris*)  
Only at Nova Lombardia on 20/11.
112. 8 **Pale-rumped Swift** (*Chaetura egregia*)  
Seen at Cristalino on 31/10 & 2/11.
114. 3 **Fork-tailed Palm-Swift** (*Tachornis squamata*)  
Seen at Serra das Araras on 19/10.
112. 12 **Sick's Swift\*** (*Chaetura meridionalis*)  
Not recognised as a full species by some authorities but rather as a subspecies of Ashy-tailed Swift (or Ashy-throated Swift in ABOB) *Ch. Andrei*. Seen at Intervalles on 6/11 and Itatiaia on 12&13/11.
114. 5 **SAW-BILLED HERMIT** (*Ramphodon naevius*) **Near-threatened.**  
Seen at the feeders at Folha Seca on 15/11.
116. 1 **Black Jacobin\*** (*Florisuga fuscus*)  
Common around the feeders at Itatiaia, Intervalles and Sanat Teresa.
116. 4 **White-vented Violet-ear** (*Colibri serrirostris*)  
At Chapada dos Guimaraes on 25/10 and Canastra on 8&9/11.
116. 7 **Scale-throated Hermit\*** (*Phaethornis eurynome*)  
At Intervalles on 6/11 and Nova Lombardia on 20/11.
118. 3 **Planalto Hermit** (*Phaethornis pretrei*)  
At Chapada dos Guimaraes on 24/10 and Nova Lombardia on 20/11.
118. 5 **Cinnamon-throated Hermit** (*Phaethornis nattereri*)  
A very washed out specimen seen along the Transpantaneira just outside Porto Joffre on 23/10.
118. 7 **Reddish Hermit** (*Phaethornis ruber*)  
Seen at Pereque on 15/11.
118. 10 **MINUTE HERMIT** (*Phaethornis idaliae*)  
Seen daily in the forests of Linhares and Sooretama.
118. 11 **Swallow-tailed Hummingbird** (*Eupetomena macrourus*)

- Common and seen regularly throughout SE Brazil.
118. 12 **White-necked Jacobin** (*Florisuga mellivora*)  
Seen only at Cristalino on 2/11
120. 1 **Black-throated Mango** (*Anthracothorax nigricollis*)  
Only at Pereque on 15/11.
120. 6 **Plovercrest\*** (*Stephanoxis lalandi*)  
Regrettably only females seen at Agulhas Negras on 12&13/11.
120. 9 **FRILLED COQUETTE** (*Lophornis magnificus*)  
One of the absolute star birds of the trip. These tiny stunning avian jewels are way better than their illustration in ABOB. Seen at Itatiaia 11&12/10 and at Nova Lombardia on 20/11.
120. 10 **Festive Coquette** (*Lophornis chalybea*)  
A brilliant male at the feeders at Folha Seca on 15/11.
122. 5 **Glittering-bellied Emerald** (*Chlorostilbon aureoventris*)  
Seen at feeders in Vargem Bonita near Canastra on 8&9/11 and at Nova Lombardia on 20/11.
122. 6 **Fork-tailed Woodnymph** (*Thalurania furcata*)  
Seen in the grounds of the lodge at Cristalino on 30&31/10.
122. 8 **Violet-capped Woodnymph\*** (*Thalurania glaucopis*)  
Seen regularly at most sites throughout SE Brazil.
122. 9 **Rufous-throated Sapphire** (*Hylocharis sapphirina*)  
A cracking male with brilliant red throat and distinctive red bill at Sooretama on 23/11.
122. 10 **White-chinned Sapphire** (*Hylocharis cyanus*)  
This species also with a distinctive red bill seen at Folha Seca on 15/10. and Linhares on 22/11.
122. 11 **Gilded Sapphire** (*Hylocharis chrysura*)  
Only once on the Transpantania near Porto Joffre on 23/10.
124. 8 **SOMBRE HUMMINGBIRD** (*Campylopterus curvipennis*)  
Missed this species at Folha Seca but eventually seen well at Nova Lombardia on 20/11. Also seen in the forest at Caetes on 26/11.
124. 9 **BRAZILIAN RUBY** (*Clytolaema rubricauda*)  
At the feeders of Itatiaia, Folha Seca and Santa Tereza.
126. 3 **Versicoloured Emerald** (*Agyrtria versicolor*)  
Seen at Intervalles on 5&6/11 and Nova Lombardia on 20/11.
126. 4 **Glittering-throated Emerald** (*Polyerata fimbriata*)  
Seen along the remnant forest edge at Faz. St Teresa, Pantanal on 20&21/10.
126. 5 **Sapphire-spangled Emerald** (*Polyerata lactea*)  
Seen at Nova Lombardia on 20/11.
128. 4 **HYACINTH VISORBEARER** (*Augastes scutatus*) **Near-threatened**  
Great views of a perched male of this stunning species at Cipo on 10/11.
128. 5 **Black-eared Fairy** (*Heliothrix aurita*)  
A couple seen on the Serra at Cristalino on 1/11.
128. 8 **STRIPE-BREASTED STARTRHOAT** (*Helionmaste squamosus*)  
Seen at feeders in Vargem Bonita near Canastra on 8&9/11.
128. 10 **Amethyst Woodstar** (*Calliphlox amethystina*)  
Female at Itatiaia on 11/11, then males at Folha Seca on 15/11, Nova Lombardia on 20/11.
130. 3 **White-tailed Trogon** (*Trogon viridis*)  
At Intervalles 5&6/11, Folha Seca 15/11, Nova Lombardia 20/11 and Domingos Martins 27/11
130. 4 **Collared Trogon** (*Trogon collaris*)  
Only at Linhares on 22/11.
130. 6 **Black-throated Trogon** (*Trogon rufus*)  
At Intervalles on 5&6/11.
130. 7 **Surucua Trogon\*** (*Trogon surrucura*)  
At Intervalles on 5&6/11 and Domingos Martins on 27/11.
130. 8 **Blue-crowned Trogon** (*Trogon curucui*)  
Near Porto Joffre on 23/10, Chapada dos Guimaraes on 25/10 and Cristalino 02/11.
130. 9 **Violaceous Trogon** (*Trogon violaceus*)  
At Cristalino on 1/11.

132. 1 **Ringed Kingfisher** (*Ceryle torquata*)  
Seen daily in the Pantanal and regularly along the river at Cristalino also at Cananeia on 17/11.
132. 2 **Amazon Kingfisher** (*Chloroceryle amazona*)  
Seen daily in the Pantanal and regularly along the river at Cristalino.
132. 3 **Green Kingfisher** (*Chloroceryle americana*)  
Seen daily in the Pantanal and regularly along the river at Cristalino.
132. 4 **Green and Rufous Kingfisher** (*Chloroceryle inda*)  
Only once from the river at Cristalino on 31/10.
132. 5 **American Pygmy-Kingfisher** (*Chloroceryle aenea*)  
One or two singles seen most days in the Pantanal and at Cristalino on 1/11.
132. 7 **Rufous-capped Motmot\*** (*Baryphthengus ruficapillus*)  
At Intervalles late afternoon on 5/11.
132. 9 **Blue-crowned Motmot** (*Momotus momota*)  
At Chapada dos Guimaraes on 24&25/10 and on the Taboca Trail, Cristalino on 2/11.
134. 5 **THREE-TOED JACAMAR** (*Jacamaralcyon tridactyla*) **Endangered**  
Seen at the stake out site, Parque Fernandais in Belo Horizonte on 10/11.
134. 7 **Blue-cheeked Jacamar** (*Galbula cyanicollis*)  
Seen at the Serra at Cristalino on 1/11
134. 9 **Rufous-tailed Jacamar** (*Galbula ruficauda*)  
Regularly in the Pantanal and Cristalino, only at Canastra in SE Brazil, and Linhares on 22/11.
134. 13 **Paradise Jacamar** (*Galbula dea*)  
Seen daily at Cristalino.
134. 14 **Great Jacamar** (*Jacamerops aureus*)  
Heard regularly at Cristalino but only seen once on the Taboca Trail on 2/11.
136. 1 **White-necked Puffbird** (*Notharcus macrorhynchos*)  
Seen from the Tower, Cristalino on 2/11.
136. 6 **Collared Puffbird** (*Bucco capensis*)  
This delightful puffbird seen on the Taboca Trail on 02/11. The fact that we saw it at all is solely down to Fransisco's remarkable eyesight as he picked out this perched bird in a dense tangle.

146. 1 **White-barred Piculet** (*Picumnus cirratus*)  
At Canastra on 8&9/11 and at Domingos Martins on 27/11.
146. 14 **Bar-breasted Piculet** (*Picumnus aurifrons*)  
In a mixed flock at Cristalino on 2/11.
146. 15 **Ochre-collared Piculet** (*Picumnus temminckii*)  
At Intervales on 4/11.

Seen regularly throughout the trip in open country.

Great views of a pair calling loudly on the Estrada Quirinao on 23/11.
150. 1 **Yellow-throated Woodpecker** (*Piculus flavigula*)  
At Linhares and Sooretama on 22&23/11.
150. 2 **Yellow-browed Woodpecker\*** (*Piculus aurulentus*) **Near-threatened**  
At Intervales on 6/11 and Nova Lombardia on 20/11.
150. 7 **Yellow-tufted Woodpecker** (*Melanerpes cruentatus*)  
Seen most days at Cristalino and at the fish ponds Alta Floresta on 3/11.
150. 8 **Yellow-fronted Woodpecker\*** (*Melanerpes flavifrons*)  
At Intervales on 4&6/11 and at Agulhas Negras Road on 13/11.
150. 9 **White Woodpecker** (*Melanerpes candidus*)  
Two flew over and one seen perched as we slammed to a halt on a motorway near Itatiaia on 18/11.
152. 1 **White-spotted Woodpecker\*** (*Veniliornis spilogaster*)  
at Intervales on 5/11 and Agulhas Negras on 13/11.
152. 2 **Little Woodpecker** (*Veniliornis passerinus*)  
Seen on 4 dates in the Pantanal, on the Fig Trail Cristalino on 2/11 and Nova Lombardia 20/11.

• **ANNOTATED MAMMAL SPECIES LIST.**

**Giant Anteater** (*Myrmecophaga tridactyla*)

This extraordinary species seen at close quarters as it shuffled its way across the grassland at Canastra.

**Maned Sloth** (*Bradypus torquatus*)

This very retracted range endemic seen from the main track at Nova Lombardia early morning on 21/11.

**White-faced Marmoset** (*Callithrix geoffroyi*)

A noisy group gave us great views on the Estrada Quirinao, Sooretama on 24/11.

**Silvery Marmoset** (*Callithrix argentata*)

Two of what were presumed to be this species were observed in the Hotel Fragment at Alta Floresta on 3/11. However according to Lambert the taxonomy of these marmosets is "unsettled"

**Dusky Titi Monkey** (*Callicebus moloch moloch*)

On the Haffer trail at Cristalino on 31/10.

**Northern Masked Titi Monkey** (*Callicebus personatus*)

A small group along one of the trails at Linhares on 22/11.

**Guianan Brown Capuchin Monkey** (*Cebus apella apella*)

First seen in the forest near Faz St Teresa and the regularly at Cristalino where it is the most commonly observed primate.

**Black-horned Capuchin** (*Cebus nigritus nigritus*)

A large troupe (30 individuals) swung through the forest at Domingos Martins - Santa Maria on 27/11.

**White-nosed Bearded Saki Monkey** (*Chiropotes albinasus*)

A small group in the canopy near the start of the Cacao Trail, Cristalino on 30/10.

**Northern Brown Howler Monkey** (*Alouatta g. guariba*)

A very unhappy looking individual from the main track at Nova Lombardia on 20/11 and other seen at Domingos Martins St Maria area on 27/11.

**Black & Gold Howler Monkey** (*Alouatta caraya*)

Seen very briefly from the road near Porto Jofre, Pantanal on 23/10.

**Red Howler Monkey** (*Alouatta seniculus*)

Fairly easy to see in the Hotel Fragment.

**White-whiskered Spider Monkey** (*Ateles marginatus*)

This localised endemic first seen at Cristalino Lodge on the New Trail on 28/10

**Maned Wolf** (*Pseudalopex brachyurus*)

A single animal seen in the chilly early morning loping its way across the plateau at Canastra on 8/11.

**Crab-eating Fox** (*Cerdocyon thous*)

Seen wandering along the track to Santa Isabelle Farm near Porto Jofre, Pantanal 23/10.

**Crab-eating Raccoon** (*Cerdocyon thous*)

Seen crossing a trail at Linhares on 22/11.

**South American Coati** (*Nasua nasua*)

Seen at dusk along the track to Santa Isabelle Farm' Pantanal 23/10 and at Linhares on 22/11.

**Tayra** (*Eira barbara*)

Looking somewhat like an oversized pine marten with a dirty yellow chest we had great views of one as it wandered across one of the trails near a waterfall at Intevales on 5/11.

**Neotropical Otter** (*Lontra longicaudis*)

A single otter upstream from the lodge on 31/10.

**Giant (River) Otter** (*Pteronura brasiliensis*)

A fantastic group on the of 11 on the Piaxaim River late afternoon on 20/10 and later a small group observed along the Rio Cristalino near the Cigana on 31/10.

**Ocelot** (*Leopardus pardalis*)

Poor views of an individual on Agulhas Negras Rd on 12/11.

**Tapir** (*Tapiris terrestris*)

We seemed to be extremely fortunate with several sightings of this animal. First seen at dusk crossing the Piexaim River to emerge on the far bank on

21/10, then spotlit as we drove back from Porto Joffre on 22/10 and seen on 4 separate occasions at Cristalino.

**Grey Brocket Deer** (*Mazama gouazoubira*)

In a marshy area from the Transpantiera near Faz St Teresa on 24/10.

**Marsh Deer** (*Blastocerus dichotomus*)

Seen from the Transpantianiera on 20/10,

**Guianan Squirrel** (*Sciurus aestuans*)

One at Cristalino.

**Brazilian Porcupine** (*Coendu prehensilsi*)

Seen in the haedlight at 3.30 am on the access road to Itatiaia on 12/11.

**Capybara** (*Hydrochaeris hydrochaeris*)

Common in the Pantanal and seen early morning at the fish ponds at Alta Floresta.

**Red-rumped (Brazilian) Agouti** (*Dasyprocta leporina*)

A couple of individuals seen walking along a trail at Linhares on 22/11.

**Azara's Agouti** (*Dasyprocta azarae*)

Easily seen on the lawns around the Hotel Floresta Amazonica, adjacent to the Hotel Fragment.

**Brazilian Rabbit** (*Sylvilagus brasiliensis*)

From the main track at Nova Lombardia early morning on 21/11.
