

● ANNOTATED BIRD LIST

TINAMOUS: TINAMIDAE

Great Tinamou (*Tinamus major*)

A single bird flushed from the Harpy Eagle trail at Gareno on 16/02.

Tawny-breasted Tinamou (*Nothocercus julius*)

A couple of birds calling from forest along the road to Tapichalaca on 25/01.

Little Tinamou (*Crypturellus soui*)

Flushed from the trail at El Para Reserve on 13/02. Also very vocal at Canande.

GREBES: PODICIPEDIDAE

Pied-billed Grebe (*Podilymbus podiceps*)

Several birds on San Pablo Lake on 25/02.

FRIGATEBIRDS: FREGATIDAE

Magnificent Frigatebird (*Fregata magnificens*)

One over shrimp ponds near Guyaquil 02/02; many along the coast near Esmeraldas on 27/02.

CORMORANTS: PHALACROCORACIDAE

Neotropic Cormorant (*Phalacrocorax brasilianus*)

Several at shrimp ponds near Guyaquil 02/02; on the lake below Papallacta on 05/02 and San Pablo Lake on 25/02.

SCREAMERS: ANHIDAE

Horned Screamer (*Anhima cornuta*)

A single bird in a marsh near Manglares Churute on 02/02.

DUCKS, GEESE & SWANS: ANATIDAE

Black-bellied Whistling-Duck (*Dendrocygna autumnalis*)

Several in the Santa Rosa marsh on 02/02.

Torrent Duck (*Merganetta armata*)

A pair in the river below the EERSA hydro plant between Loja and Zamora on 22/01.

White-checked Pintail (*Anas bahamensis*)

Several at the shrimp ponds near Guyaquil 02/02.

Yellow-billed Pintail (*Anas georgica*)

Several on Lake Torreadora in Cajas NP on 18/01 and on San Pablo Lake on 25/02.

Blue-winged Teal (*Anas discors*)

Several on Lake Torreadora in Cajas NP on 18/01 and on San Pablo Lake on 25/02.

Andean Ruddy-Duck (*Oxyura ferruginea*)

A few on San Pablo Lake on 25/02.

HERONS, BITTERN & ARDEIDAE

Fasciated Tiger-Heron (*Tigrisoma fasciatum*)

A single in a river near El Para Reserve on 13/02.

Cocoi Heron (*Ardea cocoi*)

Several in the Santa Rosa marsh on 02/02.

Great Egret (*Ardea alba*)

Seen only once on the drive to the Gualaceo/Limon Rd. on 20/01.

Snowy Egret (*Egretta thula*)

Several in the Santa Rosa marsh on 02/02.

Little Blue Heron (*Egretta caerulea*)

At the Santa Rosa marsh on 02/02; San Pablo Lake on 25/02 and at Tundaloma 26/02.

Cattle Egret (*Bubulcus ibis*)

Seen on 30/01, 02/02 and 25/02.

Striated Heron (*Butorides striatus*)

Near the Bombascuro entrance of Podocarpus NP on 23/01, Santa Rosa marsh 02/02.

Black-crowned Night-Heron (*Nycticorax nycticorax*)

A single at Santa Rosa marsh on 02/02.

IBISES & SPOONBILLS: THRESKIORNITHIDAE

Green Ibis (*Mesembrinibis cayennensis*)

A pair over the road at Yalare Reserve on 26/02.

White Ibis (*Eudocimus albus*)

A few at Santa Rosa marsh on 02/02.

AMERICAN VULTURES: CATHARTIDAE

Andean Condor (*Vultur gryphus*) **Near-threatened**

A single over the summit of Papallacta on 05/02

Black Vulture (*Coragyps atratus*)

Common

Turkey Vulture (*Cathartes aura*)

Common

Greater Yellow-headed Vulture (*C. melambrotus*)

Flying above the forest at Gareno on 14&15/02.

KITES, EAGLES & HAWKS: ACCIPITRIDAE

Gray-headed Kite (*Leptodon cayanensis*)

Single seen in the upper part of Buenaventura on the Zambotambo Rd. on 01/02.

Swallow-tailed Kite (*Elanoides forficatus*)

Seen on 7 separate dates at Buenaventura, Loreto Rd., Mindo and Canande.

Snail Kite (*Rostramus sociabilis*)

Only once at the marsh near Manglares Churute on 02/02.

Double-toothed Kite (*Harpagus bidentatus*)

Seen on the road from Ibarra to San Lorenzo on 25/02 and on the road to Canande on 27/02.

Plumbeous Kite (*Ictinia plumbea*)

Seen at Buenaventura on 31/01, at Tundaloma Lodge on 26/02 and Canande on 27/02.

Plain-breasted Hawk (*Accipiter ventralis*)

From the Hanne Blocker trail at Utuana on 28/01, poorly at Yanacocha on 03/02 and near Guango on 05/02.

White Hawk (*Leucopternis albicollis*)

Only seen from the main road at Gareno 14/02.

Gray-backed Hawk (*Leucopternis occidentalis*) **Endangered**

Seen in the upper part of Buenaventura on the Zambotambo Rd. on 01/02

Barred Hawk (*Leucopternis princeps*)

Seen along the road near Milpe Cloudforest Reserve on 23/02.

Savanna Hawk (*Buteogallus meridionalis*)

From the verge at the disused toll booth on the road from Santa Rosa and Guyaquil on 02/02.

Great Black-Hawk (*Buteogallus urubitinga*)

Three birds seen in the upper part of Buenaventura on the Zambotambo Rd. on 01/02.

Harris's Hawk (*Parabuteo unicinctus*)

Flying around the Hotel Sol y Agua at Yunguilla on 20/01, the Zapotillo Rd. on 28/01.

Black-chested Buzzard-Eagle (*Geranoaetus melanoleucus*)

A juvenile seen at Yunguilla on 19/01, at Podocarpus NP on 22/01 and at Papallacta on 05/02.

Roadside Hawk (*Buteo magnitostris*)

Recorded regularly throughout the trip.

Broad-winged Hawk (*Buteo platypterus*)

Recorded regularly throughout the trip.

Short-tailed Hawk (*Buteo brachyurus*)

Flying over Buenaventura 31/01.

Harpy Eagle (*Harpia harpyja*) **Near-threatened**

Brief view of an adult over the forest and the juvenile at the nest at Gareno on 16/02.

Black Hawk-Eagle (*Spizaetus tyrannus*)

Flying high over the forest at Yalare on 26/02 and Canande on 28/02.

Ornate Hawk-Eagle (*Spizaetus ornatus*)

Scope views of an adult female on the Harpy Eagle trail at Gareno on 15/02

FALCONS & CARACARAS: FALCONIDAE

Black Caracara (*Daptrius ater*)

Seen at Gareno Lodge on 13&15/02.

Northern Crested-Caracara (*Caracara cheriway*)

At Buenaventura on 31/01 and on 02/02.

Carunculated Caracara (*Phalcoboenus carunculatus*)

At Lake Torreadora at Cajas NP on 18/01, along the Gualaceo/Limon Rd. on 21/01 and at Papallacta on 05/02.

Barred Forest-Falcon (*Micrastur ruficollis*) H.

Heard only at Septimo Paraiso on 22/02.

Laughing Falcon (*Herpetotheres cachinnans*) H.

Heard only at Utuana on 28/01 and at Canande on 02/03.

American Kestrel (*Falcon sparverius*)

Recorded regularly throughout the trip.

Bat Falcon (*Falco rufigularis*)

Distant views of a perched bird at Milpe Cloudforest Reserve on 23/02.

CURASSOWS, GUANS & CHACHALACAS: CRACIDAE

Speckled Chachalaca (*Ortalis guttata*)

In open country at Zamora airstrip on 23/01 and from the old Loja/Zamora Rd. on 24/01

Rufous-headed Chachalaca (*Ortalis erythropera*) **Vulnerable**

At Buenaventura on 02/02

Bearded Guan (*Penelope barbata*) **Vulnerable**

A pair at the forest edge at Cajanuma entrance to Podocarpus NP on 22/01.

Andean Guan (*Penelope montagnii*)

Yanacocha on 03&04/02, the Chilpe River trail at Guango on 06/02 and at the lodge on 07/02.

Wattled Guan (*Aburria aburri*) **Near-threatened**

Distant scope views of a perched bird at dusk at San Isidro on 07/02.

Sickle-winged Guan (*Chamaepetes goudotii*)

At the forest edge of the Bombuscaro entrance to Podocarpus NP on 23/01, and the lower entrance to Buenaventura on 01/02.

NEW WORLDS QUAILS: ODONTOPHORIDAE

Rufous-fronted Wood-Quail (*Odontophorus erythrops*) **H.**

Heard at very close quarters for at least 15 minutes on the Main Trail at Canande on 02/03 but the birds just would not show from the other side of the dry gulley. Finally they wandered off.

DARK-BACKED WOOD-QUAIL (*Odontophorus melanonotus*) **Endemic Vulnerable**

Two birds encountered by chance on the trail at Angel Paz Refugio on 23/02.

RAILS, GALLINULES & COOTS: RALLIDAE

White-throated Crake (*Laterallus albigularis*)

Heard on several occasions but a pair seen in the lower valley below Mindo on 22/02.

Ecuadorian Rail (*Rallus aequatorialis*)

Three birds in the marsh by San Pablo Lake on 25/02.

Blackish Rail (*Pardirallus nigricans*)

Heard at Zamora airport and a pair seen in a marsh near Archidona on 11/02.

Rufous-necked Wood-Rail (*Aramides axillaris*)

Poor views of a bird along Trail 4 at Jorupe on 29/01.

Purple Gallinule (*Porphyryla martinica*)

Two birds in the marsh near Manglares Churute on 02/02.

Common Gallinule (*Gallinula chloropus*)

Several birds at the edge of San Pablo Lake on 25/02.

Andean Coot (*Fulica ardesiaca*)

Several birds on San Pablo Lake on 25/02.

JACANAS: JACANIDAE

Wattled Jacana (*Jacana jacana*)

A couple at Santa Rosa marsh on 02/02.

SANDPIPERS, SNIPES & PHALAROPEs: SCOLOPACIDAE

Greater Yellowlegs (*Tringa melanoleuca*)

Several birds at the edge of San Pablo Lake on 25/02.

Lesser Yellowlegs (*Tringa flavipes*)

Several birds at the edge of San Pablo Lake on 25/02.

Solitary Sandpiper (*Tringa solitaria*)

A few at Santa Rosa marsh 02/02.

Spotted Sandpiper (*Actitis macularia*)

Several at the shrimp ponds between Buenaventura and Santa Rosa on 02/02 with other odd singles throughout the trip.

Semipalmated Sandpiper (*Calidris pusilla*)

Several at the shrimp ponds between Buenaventura and Santa Rosa on 02/02

Western Sandpiper (*Calidris mauri*)

Several at the shrimp ponds between Buenaventura and Santa Rosa on 02/02

Least Sandpiper (*Calidris minutilla*)

Several at the shrimp ponds between Buenaventura and Santa Rosa on 02/02

SEEDSNIPES: THINOCORIDAE

Rufous-bellied Seedsnipe (*Attagos gayi*)

A pair at the summit of Papallacta on 05/02.

STILTS & AVOCETS: RECURVIROSTRIDAE

Black-necked Stilt (*Himantopus mexicanus*)

Several at the Santa Rosa marsh on 02/02.

PLOVERS & LAPWINGS: CHARADRIDAE

Wilson 's Plover (*Charadrius wilsonia*)

A few at the shrimp ponds between Buenaventura and Santa Rosa on 02/02

Collared Plover (*Charadrius collaris*)

A few at Santa Rosa marsh 02/02.

GULLS & TERNS: LARIDAE

Franklin's Gull (*Larus pipixcan*)

Several at the shrimp ponds between Buenaventura and Santa Rosa on 02/02 and many at a rivermouth n the Pacific coast near Esmeraldas 27/02.

Sandwich Tern (*Sterna sandvicensis*)

Several at the shrimp ponds between Buenaventura and Santa Rosa on 02/02.

PIGEONS & DOVES: COLUMBIDAE

Rock Pigeon (*Columba livia*)

Only recorded on 4 dates, all in the south

Band-tailed Pigeon (*Columba fasciata*)

Common; recorded throughout the trip except at Canande.

Scaled Pigeon (*Columba speciosa*)

At the Loreto Rd. on 11/02 and at Yalare Reserve on 26/02.

Pale-vented Pigeon (*Columba cavennensis*)

Seen around San Lorenzo, Tundaloma and Yalare Reserve on 25&26/02.

Ruddy Pigeon (*Columba subvinacea*)

At Yalare Reserve on 26/02 and Canande on 28/02.

Plumbeous Pigeon (*Columba plumbea*)

Recorded on several dates (5 or more) throughout the trip.

Dusky Pigeon (*Columba goodsoni*)

Seen first at Yalare Reserve on 26&27/02 and at Canande 01&02/03.

Eared Dove (*Zenaida auriculata*)

Recorded on several dates (5 or more) throughout the trip.

Common Ground-Dove (*Columbina passerina*)

In the Equator Line Valley on 17/02.

Ruddy Ground-Dove (*Columbina talpacoti*)

Only at Gareno Lodge on 16/02.

Ecuadorian Ground-Dove (*Columbina buckleyi*)

At Sozorango on 28/01 and at the Santa Rosa marsh on 02/02.

Croaking Ground-Dove (*Columbina cruziana*)

Recorded on several dates (5 or more) but only in the south of Ecuador.

Blue Ground-Dove (*Claravis pretiosa*)

At the Santa Rosa marsh on 02/02.

White-tipped Dove (*Leptotila verreauxi*)

Common in the south but apparently less so in the north.

Gray-fronted Dove (*Leptotila rufaxilla*)

At Cabanas Copalinga near Bombuscaro entrance to Podocarpus NP. on 23/02

Ochre-bellied Dove (*Leptotila ochraceiventris*) **H. Vulnerable**

Heard at a stop en route to Sozorango on 28/02 and calling persistently at Jorupe on 29/01.

White-throated Quail-Dove (*Geotrygon frenata*)

Heard regularly throughout the south but only seen on the Guacamayos Ridge on 09/02.

PARROTS & MACAWS: PSITTACIDAE

Chestnut-fronted Macaw (*Ana severa*)

Fly-over only at the Loreto Rd. on 11/02.

Red-masked Parakeet (*Aratinga erythrogenys*) **Near-threatened**

Several fly-bys in the south but seen perched on the Perio de Orces Trail at Buenaventura 31/01. Also at lower level at Buenaventura on 02/02 on the old road from Piñas to Machala.

White-eyed Parakeet (*Aratinga leucophthalmus*)

Fly-overs only at Zamora airstrip on 23/01 and at El Para Reserve on 13/02.

Golden-plumed Parakeet (*Leptosittaca branickii*) **Vulnerable**

A small group of 5 or 6 of these elegant parrots feeding by the road en route from Cerro Toledo to Tapichalaca on 25/01.

Maroon-tailed Parakeet (*Pyrrhura melanura*)

Several fly-bys before being seen well at Milpe Cloudforest Reserve on 23&24/02.

ELORO PARAKEET (*Pyrrhura orcesi*) **Endemic Endangered**

Poor views of a pair feeding in a tree from the old road to Zambotambo in the upper part of Buenaventura on 01/02.

WHITE-NECKED PARAKEET (*Pyrrhura albipectus*) **Endemic Vulnerable**

Scope views at the Bombuscaro entrance of Podocarpus NP. on 23/02

Pacific Parrotlet (*Forpus sclateri*)

Seen regularly in the south, first in the grounds of the Sol y Agua Hosteria at Yunguilla on 19/01. Then at Tapichalaca, Zapotillo Rd. and Jorupe.

Gray-checked Parakeet (*Brotogeris pyrrhopterus*) **Endangered**

Seen from the road between Utuana and Macara on 28/01, at the Zapotillo Rd. on 29/01 and from the road between Macara and Catacocha on 30/01.

Cobalt-winged Parakeet (*Brotogeris cyanoptera*)

Several birds perched at El Para on 13/02 and from the road at Gareno 14/02.

Blue-fronted Parrotlet (*Touit dilectissima*)

Fly-bys only from the road at Milpe on 24/02 and also at Yalare on 27/02.

Black-headed Parrot (*Pionites melanocephala*)

Great views of a feeding group from the road at Gareno on 14/02.

Rose-faced Parrot (*Pionopsitta pulchra*)

Seen in flight a couple of times before obtaining scope views of a small group feeding in bushes from the Botrosa logging road in the upper part of Canande on 02/03.

Blue-headed Parrot (*Pionus menstruus*)

Scope views of a perched bird at Río Noschinípar at Gareno on 15/02 then at Tundaloma 26/02 and Yalare on 27/02.

Red-billed Parrot (*Pionus sordidus*)

At San Isidro on 08/02, followed by close-up views of several perched birds at the Guacamayos Ridge on 11&12/02

White-capped Parrot (*Pionus seniloides*)

Seen from the Macuculoma Trail at San Isidro on 08/02.

Bronze-winged Parrot (*Pionus chalcopterus*)

Fly-by at Buenaventura on 01/02, then seen perched at Milpe Cloudforest Reserve on 23/02, from Tundaloma Lodge 25/02 and at Canande on 28/02 & 01/03.

Red-lored Amazon (*Amazona autumnalis*)

Good flight views at Yalare on 26/02.

Scaly-naped Amazon (*Amazona mercenaria*)

Fly-bys at Cajanuma on 24/01, on the road to Tapichalaca on 25/01, then an adult feeding young lower down the valley at Tapichalaca on 27/01. Also at Guacamayos Ridge on 09/02.

Mealy Amazon (*Amazona farinosa*)

Fly by at Yalare on 26/02 and then good flight views at Canade on 28/02 & 01/03.

CUCKOOS & ANIS: CUCULIDAE

Squirrel Cuckoo (*Piaya cayana*)

Seen only at Bombuscaro in the south on 23/01 and then at Gareno on 14/02 and daily at Milpe, Yalare and Canade.

Black-bellied Cuckoo (*Piaya melanogaster*)

From the road at Gareno on 14&15/02.

Smooth-billed Ani (*Crotophaga ani*)

Recorded regularly throughout the trip.

Groove-billed Ani (*Crotophaga sulcirostris*)

Seen only at Yunguilla on 19/01.

Striped Cuckoo (*Tapera naevia*)

On the Zapotillo Road on 29/01.

TYPICAL OWLS: STRIGIDAE

Chocó Screech-Owl (*Otus centralis*) H.

Two birds calling at dusk close to the road by the lodge at Canande on 02/03 but regrettably they refused to show themselves.

Cloud-forest Pygmy-Owl (*Glaucidium nubicola*) **Vulnerable**

Seen being mobbed by smaller passerines on the Snake Trail at Septimo Paraiso on 22/02.

West Peruvian Pygmy-Owl (*Glaucidium peruanum*)

In the late afternoon on the road to Zapotillo on 28/01.

Crested Owl (*Lophostrix cristata*)

A stunning roosting pair staked out near the entrance to Gareno Lodge on 14&16/02.

Spectacled Owl (*Pulsatrix perspicillata*) H.

Heard from the lodge clearing at Gareno 15/02.

Band-bellied Owl (*Pulsatrix melanonota*)

Adult and juvenile heard calling nightly at Cabanas Copalinga but remained unseen.

Black-and-white Owl (*Strix nigrolineata*)

Fantastic views of this great owl at dusk at the upper entrance to Buenaventura on 30/01.

Mottled Owl (*S. virgata*) H.

Heard calling at night along the trail at Yunguilla on 18/01 but not pursued.

Short-eared Owl (*A. flammeus*)

One over the hillside near Yanacocha on 04/02.

San Isidro Owl (*sp. novo*)

This "new" owl, possibly intermediate between Black-banded and Black and White easily seen at night around the cabins at San Isidro. According to an entry in the lodge log book by a researcher there are 3 adults and 2 juveniles present. Feather and blood samples have recently been taken so hopefully this will resolve the mystery of this species.

POTOOS: NYCTIBIIDAE

Great Potoo (*Nyctibius gradis*) H.

Heard from the cabins pre-dawn at Garenó on 14/02

Common Potoo (*Nyctibius griseus*)

A daytime roosting bird at Bellavista Lodge on 20/02

Rufous Potoo (*Nyctibius bracteatus*)

Fantastic views of this rare Potoo staked out at Garenó Lodge on 13&15/02. It really is a stunning species.

NIGHTHAWKS & NIGHTJARS: CAPRIMULGIDAE

Rufous-bellied Nighthawk (*Lurocalis rufiventris*)

At dusk flying over Guango on 06/02, near San Isidro 08/02, and seen roosting at Angel Paz Refugio on 21/02.

Pauraque (*Nyctidromus albicollis*)

Seen very regularly (10+) dates including roosting birds on the Hanne Blocker Trail on 28/01 and at Jorupe on 29/01.

Band-winged Nightjar (*Caprimulgus longirostris*)

Seen at dusk on the Gulaceo/Limon Rd on 20/01, and at Bombuscaro on 23&24/01.

Lyre-tailed Nightjar (*Uropsalis lyra*)

A female only at the quarry at Km 87 on the road from Tena to San Isidro.

SWIFTS: APODIDAE

White-collared Swift (*Streptoprocne zonaris*)

Recorded regularly throughout the trip.

Chestnut-collared Swift (*Cypseloides rutilus*)

Seen regularly in the south including a nesting colony in the church at Sozorango 28/01 and then at San Isidro on 07&08/02.

Spot-fronted Swift (*Cypseloides. cherriei*) **Data deficient**

Three of these rare swifts flying low around San Isidro on 08/02 and over Tandayapa 19/02.

Tumbes Swift (*Cypseloides. ocyptea*)

Seen flying over the Zapotillo Rd on 28&29/01.

Gray-rumped Swift (*Cypseloides. cinereiventris*)

At Garenó on 01/02, Milpe CR on 23/02 and at Canande on 02/03.

White-tipped Swift (*Aeronautes montivagua*)

Flying over the road beyond Ibarra on the way to San Lorenzo on 25/02.

Lesser Swallow-tailed Swift (*Panyptila cayennensis*)

Seen only once near Utuana on 28/01.

Neotropical Palm-Swift (*Tachornis squamata*)

At the *mauritia palms* 30 mins drive beyond Tena on the road to Garenno on 13/02.

HUMMINGBIRDS: TROCHILIDAE

Pale-tailed Barbthroat (*Threnetes niger*)

Inside the forest on the Loreto Rd. on 12/02

White-whiskered Hermit (*Phaethornis yaruqui*)

Seen on 10 dates throughout the trip; Buenaventura, Milpe CR and Canande.

Green Hermit (*Phaethornis guy*)

Seen on 24/01 along the old Loja/ Zamora Rd.

Tawny-bellied Hermit (*Phaethornis symmatophorus*)

Seen on the Macucoloma Trail at San Isidro on 08/02, at Papallacta 19&20/02 and Septimo Paraiso on 22/02.

Baron's Hermit (*Phaethornis baroni*)

At Buenaventura on 30&31/01.

Great-billed Hermit (*Phaethornis malaris*)

Seen at the lek along the Harpy Eagle Trail at Garenno on 15/02.

Straight-billed Hermit (*Phaethornis bourcierii*)

Seen along the Harpy Eagle Trail at Garenno on 15/02.

Gray-chinned Hermit (*Phaethornis griseogularis*)

Seen along the road from Utuana to Sozorango on 28/01.

White-tipped Sicklebill (*Eutoxeres aquila*)

At Buenaventura on the old road from Piñas to Machala on 02/02 and at Canande on 28/02.

Tooth-billed Hummingbird (*Androdon aequatorialis*)

Along the road at Canande on 01/03.

Blue-fronted Lancebill (*Doryfera johannae*)

Inside the forest at the Loreto Rd. on 12/02.

Green-fronted Lancebill (*Doryfera ludovicae*)

Feeding in streamside flowers at an unknown stream on the Mariposas de Mindo Rd. on 22/02

Gray-breasted Sabrewing (*Camopylopterus largipennis*)

In the cabin clearing at Garenno Lodge on 14 & 15/02

Napo Sabrewing (*Camopylopterus Villaviscensio*) **Near-threatened**

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Garenno Lodge on 15/02.

White-necked Jacobin (*Florisuga mellivora*)

At the hummingbird feeders at Buenaventura on 31/01 & 01/02, Tandayapa Lodge 17/02, Sachatamia Lodge on 22&23/02. and Canande 28/02 & 01/03.

Brown Violetear (*Colibri delphinae*)

At the hummingbird feeders at Buenaventura on 31/01 & 01/02, Tandayapa Lodge 17/02, Sachatamia Lodge on 22&23/02.

Green Violetear (*Colibri thalassinus*)

Absent from the south but seen in the north; Verdecocha 03/02, San Isidro 08/02, Loreto Rd. 11/02, Mindo and Milpe CR.

Sparkling Violetear (*Colibri coruscans*)

Recorded on 14 dates throughout the trip but absent from the northwest.

Black-throated Mango (*Anthracothrax nigricollis*)

Seen along the road between San Isidro and Archidona on 10/02.

Rufous-crested Coquette (*Lophornis delatrei*)

At Zamora Airport on 23/01.

Wire-crested Thorntail (*Popelairia poleairii*)

At the hummingbird feeders at Cabanas Copalinga on 22&23/01.

Green Thorntail (*Popelairia conversii*)

At the hummingbird feeders at Buenaventura on 31/01 & 01/02, and Milpe CR 23/02 and Canande 01&02/03.

Western Emerald (*Chlorostilbon melanorhynchus*)

At the hummingbird feeders at Tandayapa on 17&18/02.

Fork-tailed Woodnymph (*Thalurania furcata*)

Inside the forest at Bombuscaro on 23/01, Loreto Rd. 12/02 and at El Para on 13/02.

Green-crowned Woodnymph (*Thalurania fannyi*)

At the hummingbird feeders at Tandayapa Lodge on 17/02, from roads around Mindo on 22&23/02, Tundaloma Lodge 26/02 and Canande Lodge on 28/02 and 01/03.

Emerald-bellied Woodnymph (*Thalurania hypochlora*)

At the hummingbird feeders at Buenaventura on 31/01 & 01/02.

Violet-bellied Hummingbird (*Damaphila juliae*)

At the hummingbird feeders at Buenaventura on 31/01 & 01/02.

Blue-headed Sapphire (*Glycocharis grayi*)

Along the road between Ibarra and El Limonal on the road to San Lorenzo on 25/02

Golden-tailed Sapphire (*Chrysuronia oenone*)

A female inside the forest at Loreto Rd. on 11/02.

Tumbes Hummingbird (*Leucippus baeri*)

Along the roadside west of Macara on 30/01.

Rufous-tailed Hummingbird (*Amazilia tzacatl*)

Recorded regularly (10+ dates) throughout the trip. Buenaventura, around Mindo and Canade.

Amazilia Hummingbird (*Amazilia amazilia*)

The "lowland form" seen at Tapichalaca on 27/01 will probably remain as Amazilia Hummingbird.

The "lowland form" also seen at Jorupe on 29/01.

LOJA HUMMINGBIRD (*Amazilia alticola*) **Endemic**

Seen at Yunguilla on 19/01 this is the "highland form" likely to be reclassified as a full species Loja Hummingbird.

Andean Emerald (*Amazilia franciae*)

At Buenaventura 31/01 & 01/01, Tandayapa 17-19/02 and around Milpe CR 21-23/02.

Glittering-throated Emerald (*Amazilia fimbriata*)

At Cabanas Copalinga on 22/01 and San Isidro 10/02.

Purple-chested Hummingbird (*Amazilia rosenergi*)

At Tundaloma on 25/02 and Canande on 28/02 and 01/03.

White-vented Plumeleteer (*Chalybura buffonii*)

A female en route from Utuana to Sozorango on 28/01 and another at Buenaventura on 31/01

Bronze-tailed Plumeleteer (*Chalybura urochrysis*)

Only once, a male, briefly at Canande on 02/03.

Speckled Hummingbird (*Adelomyia melanogenya*)

Common. Recorded regularly (15+ dates) throughout the trip.

Purple-bibbed Whitetip (*Urosticte benjamini*)

At the hummingbird feeders at T andayapa on 17&18/02 and at Sachatamia Lodge 21-23/02.

Ecuadorian Piedtail (*Phlogophilus hemileucurus*) **Near-threatened**

In the forest at Bombuscaro on 23/01, and on 11/02 inside the forest at Loreto Rd.

Empress Brilliant (*Heliodoxa imperatrix*)

Seen daily from 17-23/02 at T andayapa and around Milpe.

Green-crowned Brilliant (*Heliodoxa jacula*)

Buenaventura 31/01-01/02, T andayapa on 17/02, Milpe CR on 23/02 and Canande 28/02.

Violent-fronted Brilliant (*Heliodoxa leadbeateri*)

Daily at the hummingbird feeders at Cabanas Copalinga 22-24/02.

Black-throated Brilliant (*Heliodoxa schreibersii*)

Single females at the Cabanas Copalinga feeders 22-24/01 and a male at Loreto Rd on 12/02.

Fawn-breasted Brilliant (*Heliodoxa rubinooides*)

First seen at Tapichalaca 25-27/01 and then recorded regularly (10 dates) throughout the trip.

Ecuadorian Hillstar (*Oreotrochilus chimborazo*) **Endemic**

At Cajas NP above Lake Torreadora on 18/01

White-tailed Hillstar (*Urochroa bougueri*)

Inside the forest at the Loreto Rd. on 11&12/02, and T andayapa on 20/02.

Giant Hummingbird (*Patagona gigas*)

Only once, in the grounds of the Uzhupud Hotel at Gualaceo on 19/01.

Shining Sunbeam (*Aglæactis cupripennis*)

Cajas NP on 18/01, Yunguilla 19/01, near the Uzhupud Hotel at Gualaceo on 19/01 and
Thermas de Papallacta on 05/02.

Mountain Velvetbreast (*Lafresnaya lafresnayi*)

A female at the forest edge at Cajanuma on 22/01, males at Verdecocha on 03/02 and Guango
on 06&07/02.

Great Sapphirewing (*Pterophanes syanopterus*)

At the feeders along and at the end of the Inca Trail at Yanacocha on 03/02.

Bronzy Inca (*Coeligena coeligena*)

On the old Loja/Zamora Rd. on 24/01 and on the feeders at San Isidro on 07&08/02.

Brown Inca (*Coeligena wilsoni*)

At Buenaventura on the old road from Piñas to Machala on 02/02 and at Milpe 23/02.

Collared Inca (*Coeligena torquata*)

Recorded regularly (10 dates) throughout the trip.

Buff-winged Starfrontlet (*Coeligena lutetiae*)

At the feeders at Tapichalaca on 25&26/01 and Verdecocha 03/02.

Rainbow Starfrontlet (*Coeligena iris*)

At Cajanuma on 22&24/01.

Sword-billed Hummingbird (*Ensifera ensifera*)

This extraordinary hummingbird seen on the feeders at the end of the Inca Trail at Yanacocha on 03/02 and at Guango Lodge on 06/02.

Buff-tailed Coronet (*Boissonneaua flavescens*)

Absent from the south, seen in the north at Guango 06&07/02, Tandayapa 18&19/02.

Chestnut-breasted Coronet (*Boissonneaua matthewsii*)

Seen at 3 locations; Cajanuma 22/01, Tapichalaca 25-27/01 and Guango 06&07/02.

Velvet-purple Coronet (*Boissonneaua jardini*)

At Buenaventura 31/01, on the feeders at Tandayapa 18-20/02 and around Mindo 22-25/02.

Amethyst-throated Sunangel (*Helianthus amethysticollis*)

At Cajanuma 24/01 and on the feeders at Tapichalaca on 25&26/01.

Gorgeted Sunangel (*Helianthus strophianus*)

At the feeders at Bellavista on 18-20/02.

Tourmaline Sunangel (*Helianthus exortis*)

On the feeders at Guango on 06&07/02.

Flame-throated Sunangel (*Helianthus micraster*)

On the road near Huashapamba on 21/01 and at the feeders at Tapichalaca on 25-27/01

Purple-throated Sunangel (*Helianthus viola*)

At Cajanuma on 22/01 and near Utuana 28/01.

Glowing Puffleg (*Eriocnemis vestitus*)

On the Gualaceo/Limon Rd on 20&21/01, Cajanuma 22&24/01, Tapichalaca on 26/01 and Guango on 07/02.

Sapphire-vented Puffleg (*Eriocnemis luciani*)

On the feeders along the Inca trail at Yanacocha on 03/02.

Golden-breasted Puffleg (*Eriocnemis mosquera*)

On the feeders along the Inca trail at Yanacocha on 03/02.

Hoary Puffleg (*Haplophaedia lugens*) **Near-threatened**

After trying several other sites finally seen by a stream behind Mindo Loma 21/01.

Booted Racket-tail (*Ocreatus underwoodii*)

First seen on 12/02 on Loreto Rd and then commonly at the feeders in the north at Tandayapa and around Milpe.

Black-tailed Trainbearer (*Lesbia victoriae*)

Poor views in the Chiche River valley north east of Quito on 05/02.

Green-tailed Trainbearer (*Lesbia nuna*)

The grounds of the Uzhupud Hotel on 19/01 and the Hanne Blocker trail at Utuana 28/01.

Purple-backed Thornbill (*Ramphomicron microthynchum*)

A female at Cajanuma on 22/01 and brief views of a male at Thermas de Papallacta on 06/02

Viridian Metaltail (*Metallura williami*)

On the Gualaceo/Limon Rd 20&21/01, at Papallacta 05/02 and Guango 06&07/02.

VIOLET-THROATED METALTAIL (*Metallura baroni*) **Endemic Endangered**

At 3600masl en route to Lake Torreadora in Cajas NP on 18/01

Neblina Metaltail (*Metallura adomae*) **Near-threatened**

An immature male above the treeline at Cerro Toledo on 25/01.

Tyrian Metaltail (*Metallura tyrianthina*)

At Cajanuma on 22/01 and at the feeders at Verdecocha on 03/02.

Rufous-capped Thornbill (*Chalcostigma ruficeps*)

On the feeders at Tapichalaca on 26/01.

Rainbow-bearded Thornbill (*Chalcostigma herrani*)

Near the summit of the Gualaceo/Limon Rd. on 20/01 and at Cerro Toledo 25/01.

Blue-mantled Thornbill (*Chalcostigma stanleyi*)

Near the summit of the road beyond Lake Torreadora at Cajas NP on 18/01 and along the road behind Termas de Papallacta on 05/02.

Long-tailed Sylph (*Agliocercus kingi*)

On the feeders at Tapichalaca 25-27/01, Guango 06&07/02, San Isidro 07&08/02 and the Guacamayos Ridge on 09&10/02.

Violet-tailed Sylph (*Agliocercus coelestis*)

Recorded regularly (10+ dates) throughout the trip; Buenaventura, Tandayapa and near Mindo.

Wedge-billed Hummingbird (*Schistes geoffroyi*)

At Buenaventura on 31/01 and along the road to Los Colibris near Mindo on 22/02.

Purple-crowned Fairy (*Heliothryx barroti*)

At Buenaventura on the old road from Piñas to Machala on 02/02 and Tundaloma on 25/02.

Black-eared Fairy (*Heliothryx aurita*)

At the bridge over the Rio Noschinipar at Gareno Lodge on 15/02

Long-billed Starthroat (*Helimaster longitostris*)

On 27/01 at the feeders at Tapichalaca and Buenaventura on 31/01.

Purple-throated Woodstar (*Calliphlox mitchellii*)

At the feeders at Tandayapa 17-19/02 and around Mindo 21-23/02.

Purple-collared Woodstar (*Myrtis fanny*)

A male displaying near Vilcabamba on 27/01.

White-bellied Woodstar (*Haetocercus mulsant*)

On the feeders at Tapichalaca 25-27/01, Verdecocha 03/02 and Guango on 06&07/02.

Gorgeted Woodstar (*Chaetocercus heliodor*)

Female only seen at Guango Lodge on 07/02.

TROGONS & QUETZALS: TROGONIDAE

Crested Quetzal (*Pharomachrus antisianus*) H.

Heard only at San Isidro on 08/02

Golden-headed Quetzal (*Pharomachrus auriceps*)

A female at Buenaventura on 01/02 and males at Tandayapa on 19&20/02 and near Septimo Paraiso on 24/02.

Pavonine Quetzal (*Pavoninus pavoninus*)

A female at Gareno on the Harpy Eagle trail on 16/02.

Black-tailed Trogon (*Trogon melanurus*)

From the road at Gareno on 14/02 and the Main Trail at Canande on 03/03.

Ecuadorian Trogon (*Trogon mesurus*)

Along the Zapotillo Rd. near the Peruvian border on 28/01 and on Trail 4 at Jorupe on 29/01.

Chocó Trogon (*Trogon comptus*)

On 24/02 at Milpe CR. and at Canande on 28/02 and 01/03.

Slaty-tailed Trogon (*Trogon massena*)

Along the road at Yalare Reserve on 26/02.

Amazonian White-tailed Trogon (*Trogon viridis*)

From the road at Gareno on 14/02.

Western White-tailed Trogon (*Trogon chionurus*)

At Yalare Reserve on 26/02 and at Canande on 01&02/03.

Collared Trogon (*Trogon collaris*)

On a small trail on the other side of the road from the upper entrance to Buenaventura 02/02.

Masked Trogon (*Trogon personatus*)

At Cajanuma 22/01, Buenaventura 01/02, the Río Chilpe trail at Guango on 06/02, Coyuja Forest near Guango 07/02 and Tandayapa 20/02.

Blue-crowned Trogon (*Trogon curucui*)

At Cabanas Copalinga on 22/01.

Northern Violaceous Trogon (*Trogon caligatus*)

On the Botrosa Rd at Canande on 02/03.

KINGFISHERS: ALCEDINIDAE

Ringed Kingfisher (*Megaceryle torquata*)

A single flying over the Loreto Rd on 11/02.

Amazon Kingfisher (*Choroceryle amarana*)

On the Río Bombuscaro near Cabanas Copalinga on 24/01

Green Kingfisher (*Choroceryle americana*)

At the Santa Rosa marsh on 02/02.

MOTMOTS: MOMOTIDAE

Broad-billed Motmot (*Electron platyrhynchum*)

At Buenaventura on the old road from Piñas to Machala on 31/01, and at Canande on 01/03.

Rufous Motmot (*Baryphthengus martii*)

At the bridge over the Río Noschinipar at Gareno Lodge on 14/02 and at Milpe 23&24/02.

Blue-crowned Motmot (*Momotus momota*)

On the main entrance trail to Jorupe on 29/01.

Highland Motmot (*Momotus aquatorialis*)

At the entrance to Bombuscaro on 23/01 and at San Isidro on 08&09/02.

JACAMARS: GALBULIDAE

Brown Jacamar (*Brachygalba lugubris*)

A small family group along the road to Gareno on 13/02.

Yellow-billed Jacamar (*Galbula albirostris*)

On the Minihiva Trail at Gareno on 14/02

COPPERY-CHESTED JACAMAR (*Galbula pastazae*) **Endemic Vulnerable**

On the trail at Bombuscaro on 23&24/01.

Rufous-tailed Jacamar (*Galbula ruficauda*)

On the Manakin Trail at Canande on 01/03

Great Jacamar (*Jacamerops aereus*)

Probable nesting bird on the Manakin Trail at Canande on 01/03.

PUFFBIRDS: BUCCONIDAE

White-necked Puffbird (*Notharchus macrorhynchos*)

From the road at Yalare Reserve on 26/02.

Black-breasted Puffbird (*Notharchus pectoralis*)

On the road to Concepcion at Yalare Reserve on 26 & 27/02.

Pied Puffbird (*Notharchus tectus*)

Seen daily at Tundaloma Lodge from 25-27/02.

Barred Puffbird (*Nystalus radiatus*)

From the road near Canande on 01/03.

Black-streaked Puffbird (*Malacoptila fulvogularis*) H.

Heard only on the trail at Bombuscaro on 23/01.

White-whiskered Puffbird (*Malacoptila panamensis*)

From the lower entrance road to Buenaventura on 30/01 and at Canande on 28/02 and 01/03.

Brown Nunlet (*Nonnula brunnea*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 16/02.

White-faced Nunbird (*Hapaloptila castanea*)

Great views of this very uncommon species at Guacamayos Ridge on 09/02 and along the road near Septimo Paraiso on 24/02.

Black-fronted Nunbird (*Monasa nigrifrons*)

At Gareno on 14 & 15/02.

White-fronted Nunbird (*Monasa morphocus*)

From the road at Gareno on 14/02.

NEW WORLD BARBETS: CAPITTONIDAE

Orange-fronted Barbet (*Capito squamatus*) **Near-threatened**

From the road at Yalare on 26/02 and at Canande 01 & 02/03.

Five-colored Barbet (*Capito quinticolor*) **Near-threatened**

Along the road to Concepcion on 26/02.

Gilded Barbet (*Capito auratus*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 14 & 16/02 and at Yalare Reserve on 26/02.

Lemon-throated Barbet (*Eubucco richardsoni*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15/02.

Red-headed Barbet (*E. bourcierri*)

Inside the forest on the Loreto Rd. on 12/02, Milpe on 24/02 and Canande 28/02 - 02/03.

Toucan Barbet (*Semnornis ramphastinus*) **Near-threatened**

This fantastic bird seen several times at Tandayapa 18-21/02.

TOUCANS: RAMPHASTIDAE

Emerald Toucanet (*Aulacorhynchus prasinus*)

Heard several times but only seen along the road at San Isidro 08/02.

Chestnut-tipped Toucanet (*Aulacorhynchus derbianus*)

On the lower part of the old Loja/Zamora Rd. on 24/01 and the Loreto Rd 12/02.

Crimson-rumped Toucanet (*Aulacorhynchus haematopygus*)

At Tandayapa on 18/02, Angel Paz Refugio on 21/02 and Milpe CR on 24/02.

Golden-collared Toucanet (*Selenidera reinwarditti*)

This great species seen only at El Para Reserve on 13/02.

Pale-mandibled Aracari (*Pteroglossus erythopygius*)

At Buenaventura on 31/01 & 01/02, Milpe CR 23&24/02 and Canande 01&02/03.

Stripe-billed Aracari (*Pteroglossus sanguineus*)

Along the road at Yalare on 27/02.

Many-banded Aracari (*Pteroglossus pluricinctus*)

From the bridge over the Rio Noschinipar at Gareno Lodge on 15/02.

Ivory-billed Aracari (*Pteroglossus azara*)

Seen daily at Gareno Lodge from 14-16/02.

Plate-billed Mountain-Toucan (*Andigena laminirostris*) **Near-threatened**

On 19&20/02 in the upper part of the Tandayapa Valley

Grey-breasted Mountain-Toucan (*Andigena hypoglauca*) **Near-threatened**

Frustratingly only heard 8.5 kms beyond the summit of the Gulaceo/Limon Rd. (2700m) but finally seen at Cajanuma on 22/01.

Black-billed Mountain-Toucan (*Andigena nigrirostris*)

Great views of this stunning bird on the Guacamayos Ridge 2500masl on 10/02.

Channel-billed Toucan (*Ramphastos vitellinus*)

At the start of the forest trail on the Loreto Rd. on 11/02.

Chocó Toucan (*Ramphastos brevis*)

Seen regularly in the north-west. At Milpe on 23&24/02, and Canande on 28/02-01/03.

Chestnut-mandibled Toucan (*Ramphastos swainsonii*)

Heard often and seen at Buenaventura 31/01 and Canande on 01/03.

White-throated Toucan (*Ramphastos tucanus*)

Flight view only on 15/02 at Gareno.

WOODPECKERS: PICIDAE

Lafresnaye's Piculet (*Picumnus lafresnayi*)

Copalinga 23/01, Tapichalaca 26/01, Loreto Rd 12/02, Gareno 15/02 and Canande 02/03.

Olivaceous Piculet (*Picumnus olivaceus*)

At the lower entrance to Buenaventura 30/01 and Canande 28/02 and 01/03.

Ecuadorian Piculet (*Picumnus sclateri*)

From the road between Utuana and Sozorango (1700m) on 28/01 and at Jorupe on 29/01.

Crimson-mantled Woodpecker (*Piculus rivolii*)

Recorded regularly (8 dates) throughout the trip. Only once in the south at Podocarpus NP 22/01 and then San Isidro 08/ & 09/02, El Para 13/02, the upper Tandayapa Valley 19&20/02.

Golden-olive Woodpecker (*Piculus rubiginosus*)

At Jorupe on 29/01, Buenaventura 30/01 & 01/02 and in the north at Milpe 23&24/02.

White-throated Woodpecker (*Piculus leucolaemus*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15/02

Lita Woodpecker (*Piculus litae*)

On the road to Concepción at Yalare on 26/02 and at Canande 01 & 02/03.

Scale-breasted Woodpecker (*Celeus grammicus*)

From the road at Gareno on 14/02

Cinnamon Woodpecker (*Celeus loricatus*)

At Yalare Reserve on 26&27/02.

Cream-colored Woodpecker (*Celeus flavus*)

At El Para on 13/02.

Lineated Woodpecker (*Dryocopus lineatus*)

At Milpe CR on 23&24/02 and at Canande on 01/03.

Yellow-tufted Woodpecker (*Melanerpes cruentatus*)

Cabanas Copalinga on 22/01, Bombuscaro on 23/01, El Para 13/02 and Gareno 15-16/02.

Black-cheeked Woodpecker (*Melanerpes pucherani*)

At Buenaventura on 31/01, Tundaloma 25/02, Yalare 27/02 and Canande 28/02 to 02/03.

Smoky-brown Woodpecker (*Veniliornis fumigatus*)

Buenaventura on the road to Zambotambo 01/02, Milpe CR 23&24/02.

Little Woodpecker (*Veniliornis passerinus*)

On 23/01 in the open country at Zamora airstrip.

Red-stained Woodpecker (*Veniliornis affinis*)

On 14/02 from the road near the lodge at Gareno.

Chocó Woodpecker (*Veniliornis chocoensis*) **Near-threatened**

Along the road at Canande On 01/03.

Red-rumped Woodpecker (*Veniliornis kirkii*)

On 25/02 from the lodge at Tundaloma.

Yellow-vented Woodpecker (*Veniliornis dignus*)

Along the road at San Isidro on 08/02.

Bar-bellied Woodpecker (*Veniliornis nigriceps*)

On the Inca Trail at Yanacocha on 03/02.

Scarlet-backed Woodpecker (*Veniliornis callonotus*)

On Trail 4 at Jorupe Reserve on 29/01 and along the road to Catacocha on 30/01.

Crimson-crested Woodpecker (*Campephilus melanoleucos*)

From the road near the lodge at Gareno on 14/02

Guayaquil Woodpecker (*Campephilus guayaquilensis*) **Near-threatened**

Finally from the Botrosa Rd at Canande on 02/03.

Red-necked Woodpecker (*Campephilus rubricollis*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15/02.

Powerful Woodpecker (*Campephilus pollens*)

A pair from the Inca Trail at Yanacocha on 04/02, the Antvireo Trail at San Isidro on 08/02 and the upper T andayapa Valley on 20/02.

OVENBIRDS: FURNARIDAE

Bar-winged Cinclodes (*Cinclodes fuscus*)

At Cajas NP 18/01, Gualaceo/Limon Rd. on 20&21/01 and Papallacta 05/02.

Stout-billed Cinclodes (*Cinclodes excelsior*)

At Cajas NP on 18/01 and Papallacta 05/02.

Pacific Hornero (*Furnarius cinnamomeus*)

Very common in the south, fairly common in the nothwest. Recorded on 12 dates.

Azara's Spinetail (*Synallaxis azarae*)

Heard regularly throughout except at Canande. Seen Gualaceo/Limon Rd 21/01, Cajanuma 22/01, Tapichalaca 25/01, Tandayapa Valley 17-19/02.

Dusky Spinetail (*Synallaxis moesta*)

At the lodge at Copalinga on 24/01.

Slaty Spinetail (*Synallaxis brachyura*)

At Buenaventura on the Perio de Orces Trail on 31/01 and at Septimo Paraíso on 22/02. Heard often around Milpe CR thereafter.

Dark-breasted Spinetail (*Synallaxis albigularis*)

In scrub and grassy pasture near Archidona on 11/02.

Blackish-headed Spinetail (*Synallaxis tithys*)

On Trail 4 at Jorupe Reserve on 29/01.

Rufous Spinetail (*Synallaxis unirufa*)

At Tapichalaca on 26/01.

White-browed Spinetail (*Hellmayrea gularis*)

On the Gualaceo/Limon Rd on 20/01, Tapichalaca 26/01 and Yanacocha on 04/02.

Ash-browed Spinetail (*Cranioleuca curtata*)

At the lodge at Copalinga on 23/01.

Red-faced Spinetail (*Cranioleuca erythrops*)

In the Tandayapa Valley 19/02, Septimo Paraíso 22/02, and at Milpe CR. on 23 & 24/02.

Line-checked Spinetail (*Cranioleuca antisiensis*)

At Yunguilla on 19/02, Utuana 28/01, and Buenaventura 31/01 & 01/02.

White-chinned Thistletail (*Schizoeaca fuliginosa*)

At the ruined house on the trail behind Thermas de Papallacta at dusk on 05/02.

Mouse-colored Thistletail (*Schizoeaca griseomurina*)

Just before the summit of the Gualaceo/Limon Rd on 20/01 and on the Antpitta Trail at Tapichalaca on 25/01.

Many-striped Canastero (*Asthenes flammulata*)

On Volcan Pinchincha at the top of the Teleferico on 17/01 and at Papallacta on 05/02.

Rufous-fronted Thornbird (*Pchacellodorus rufifrons*)

Lower down the valley from Tapichalaca on 26/01.

Equatorial Graytail (*Xenerpestes singularis*) **Near-threatened**

A nesting pair at the Park HQ at Bombuscaro on 23/01.

Orange-fronted Plushcrown (*Metopothrix aurantiacus*)

Nest building in the grounds of the Orchid Paradise Lodge on 11/02.

Streaked Tuftedcheek (*Pseudocolaptes boissonneautii*)

At Cajanuma on 22/01, at Tapichalaca on 26/01, the Guacamayos Ridge 09 & 10/02 and Tandayapa Valley 18-20/02.

Pacific Tuftedcheek (*Pseudocolaptes johnsoni*)

At Buenaventura on 31/01 and 01/02.

Point-tailed Palmcreeper (*Berlepschia rikeri*)

Great views of this much wanted bird at the *mauritia palms* 30 mins drive beyond Tena on the road to Garenó on 13/02.

Pearled Treerunner (*Margarornis squamiger*)

Recorded regularly (10 +dates) throughout the trip except at Canande.

Spotted Barbtail (*Premnoplex brunnescens*)

On the Guacamayos Ridge 09&10/02 and in the upper part of the Tandayapa Valley 19/02

Rusty-winged Barbtail (*Premnomis guttuligera*)

On the Guacamayos Ridge 09/02 and in the upper part of the Tandayapa Valley 19& 20/02.

Lineated Foliage-gleaner (*Syndactyla subalaris*)

At San Isidro on 07&08/02, the upper part of the Tandayapa Valley 19& 20/02, Septimo Paraiso 22/02 and at Milpe CR on 23/02.

Rufous-necked Foliage-gleaner (*Syndactyla ruficollis*) **Vulnerable**

On the Hanne Blocker Trail at Utuana on 28/01.

Scaly-throated Foliage-gleaner (*Anabacerthia variegaticeps*)

At Buenaventura 31/01 & 01/02 and at Milpe CR on 24/02.

Montane Foliage-gleaner (*Anabacerthia striaticollis*)

Near the entrance to Bombuscaro on 23/01 and the old Loja/Zamora Rd on 2/01.

Western Woodhaunter (*Hyloctistes virgatus*)

On 23/02 at Milpe CR and at Canande on 28/02 and 01/03.

Chestnut-winged Hookbill (*Ancistrops strigilatus*)

From the road at Gareno on 14/02 and on the Harpy Eagle Trail on 16/02.

Chestnut-winged Foliage-gleaner (*Philydor erythropterus*)

From the road at Gareno on 14/02.

Rufous-rumped Foliage-gleaner (*Philydor erythrocercus*)

At Gareno from the road on 14/02 and on the Harpy Eagle Trail on 15/02.

Rufous-tailed Foliage-gleaner (*Philydor ruficaudatus*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15&16/02..

Buff-fronted Foliage-gleaner (*Philydor rufus*)

At Mindo Loma on 21/02, Milpe CR on 23&24/02.

Bamboo Foliage-gleaner (*Anabazeanope dorsalis*)

In the forest at El Para on 13/02.

Olive-backed Foliage-gleaner (*Automolus infuscatus*)

At Gareno on the Minihiva Trail 14/02 and the Harpy Eagle Trail 15/02.

Ruddy Foliage-gleaner (*Automolus rubiginosus*)

In the forest at El Para on 13/02

Henna-hooded Foliage-gleaner (*Hylocryptus erythrocephalus*) **Vulnerable**

At Jorupe on 29/01.

Striped Treehunter (*Thripadectes holostictus*)

In the upper Tandayapa Valley on 18&20/02.

Streak-capped Treehunter (*Thripadectes vigiticeps*)

On the Guacamayos Ridge on 09/02 and Tandayapa Valley 18/02.

Black-billed Treehunter (*Thripadectes melanorhynchus*)

Inside the forest at the Loreto Rd. on 12/02.

Uniform Treehunter (*Thripadectes ignobilis*)

At Buenaventura on the Perico de Orces Trail on 31/01

Streaked Xenops (*Xenops rutilans*)

Recorded regularly in the south (Bombuscaro, Tapichalaca, Jorupe, Buenaventura) and on the Loreto Rd on 12/02.

Plain Xenops (*Xenops minutus*)

At Milpe CR on 24/02 and at Canande 28/02 – 02/03.

WOODCREEPERS: DENDROCOLAPTIDAE

Tyrannine Woodcreeper (*Dendrocíncla tyrannina*)

In the Tandayapa Valley on 17/02 & 20/02.

Plain-brown Woodcreeper (*Dendrocíncla fuliginosa*)

At Buenaventura on 31/01, the Loreto Rd. on 12/02 and near Mindo on 22/02.

Wedge-billed Woodcreeper (*Cyphorhynchus spirurus*)

Recorded regularly throughout the trip. (eg Bombuscaro, Buenaventura, Gareno and Canande)

Olivaceous Woodcreeper (*Sittasomus griseicapillus*)

Cabanas Copalinga on 22/01, Bombuscaro 23/01, Trail 4 at Jorupe 29/01, El Para 13/02.

Long-billed Woodcreeper (*Nasica longirostris*)

On the Main Trail at Gareno on 16/02.

Cinnamon-throated Woodcreeper (*Dendrexetastes rufigula*)

On 15/02 on the road to the bridge at Gareno.

Strong-billed Woodcreeper (*Xiphocolaptes promeropirhynchus*)

Along the road at San Isidro on 08/02 and on the Guacamayos Ridge 10/02

Northern Barred-Woodcreeper (*Dendrocolaptes sanctithomae*)

At Canande on 01 & 02/03.

Black-banded Woodcreeper (*Dendrocolaptes picumnus*)

At the bridge over the Rio Nuschinipar at Gareno on 15/02.

Ocellated Woodcreeper (*Xiphorhynchus ocellatus*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15 & 16/02.

Spix's Woodcreeper (*Xiphorhynchus spixii*)

In the forest at El Para 13/02.

Buff-throated Woodcreeper (*Xiphorhynchus guttatus*)

At Gareno on 14 & 15/02.

Black-striped Woodcreeper (*Xiphorhynchus lachrymosus*)

On the road to Concepcion at Yalare on 26 & 27/02 and Canande on 02/03.

Spotted Woodcreeper (*Xiphorhynchus erytropygius*)

On 01/02 at Buenaventura and at Milpe CR 23 & 24/02

Olive-backed Woodcreeper (*Xiphorhynchus triangularis*)

At San Isidro on 07 & 08/02, Guacamayos Ridge 09/02 and Loreto Rd on 12/02.

Streak-headed Woodcreeper (*Lepidocolaptes souleyetti*)

At Jorupe on Trail 4 on 29/01 and at Canande on 02/03.

Montane Woodcreeper (*Lepidocolaptes lachrymiger*)

Recorded regularly throughout the trip. (eg Tapichalaca, Guango, San Isidro Tandayapa Valley)

Lineated Woodcreeper (*Lepidocolaptes albolineatus*)

At El Para on 13/02.

Greater Scythebill (*Campylorhynchus pucheranii*) **Near-threatened**

Fantastic views of this rarely seen species in a mixed flock on the Guacamayos Ridge on 10/02.

Red-billed Scythebill (*Campylorhynchus trochirostris*)

At Jorupe Reserve on 29/01.

Brown-billed Scythebill (*Campylorhynchus pusillus*)

On the Tapaculo Trail opposite the shrine at Buenaventura on 02/02.

TYPICAL ANTBIRDS: THAMNOPHILAE

Fasciated Antshrike (*Cymbilaimus lineatus*)

At Gareno on 14&16/02.

Great Antshrike (*Taraba major*) H.

Heard only in the lower part of Buenaventura 31/01 and at El Para 13/02.

Collared Antshrike (*Sakesphorus bernardi*)

Only in the drier areas of the southwest; at the Catamayo Airport scrub on 27/01, Zapotillo Rd 29/01, the road to Catacocha on 30/01.

Lined Antshrike (*Thamnophilus tenuipunctatus*)

In the grounds of Cabanas Copalinga on 22&24/01.

Chapman's Antshrike (*Thamnophilus zarumae*)

On the Hanne Blocker Trail at Utuana on 28/01.

White-shouldered Antshrike (*Thamnophilus acthios*)

Inside the forest at El Para on 13/02.

Uniform Antshrike (*Thamnophilus unicolor*)

On the Perio de Orces Trail at Buenaventura 31/01 and at Angel Paz Refugio 21/02.

Plain-winged Antshrike (*Thamnophilus schistaceus*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15/02.

Western Slaty-Antshrike (*Thamnophilus atrinucha*)

At the lower entrance to Buenaventura on 30/01 and the Main Trail at Canande 28/02.

Russet Antshrike (*Thamnistes anabatinus*)

At Buenaventura on 31/01, Milpe CR on 23&24/02 and at Canande 28/02 and 01/03.

Plain Antvireo (*Dysithamnus mentalis*)

Heard on several occasions but seen only at Jorupe on 29/01.

Spot-crowned Antvireo (*Dysithamnus puncticeps*)

On the Main Trail at Canande on 28/02.

Dusky-throated Antshrike (*Thamnomanes ardesiacus*)

At Jorupe on 29/01.

Cinereous Antshrike (*Thamnomanes caesiús*)

First at Jorupe on 29/01, then Buenaventura on 30&31/01.

Griscom's Antwren (*Myrmotherula ignota*)

At Canande on 02/03 on the Botrosa Rd.

Short-billed Antwren (*Myrmotherula obscura*)

Inside the forest on the Loreto Rd. on 11/02.

Pacific Antwren (*Myrmotherula pacífica*)

Near Mindo on 22/02 and Canande on 28/02 and 01/03.

Stripe-chested Antwren (*Myrmotherula longicauda*)

By the stream at the car park at El Para on 13/02

Checker-throated Antwren (*Myrmotherula fulviventris*)

At Canande on 28/02 & 01/03.

Foothill Antwren (*Myrmotherula spodionota*)

A female on the trail from the Bombuscaro entrance of Podocarpus NP. on 23/01 and inside the forest on the Loreto Rd. on 12/02.

Rufous-tailed Antwren (*Myrmotherula erythrura*)

Poor views (for us) of this species high in the canopy at Gareno on 16/02. Seen by LN on the preceding 2 days.

White-flanked Antwren (*Myrmotherula axillaris*)

Seen daily at Gareno and Canande.

Slaty Antwren (*Myrmotherula schisticolor*)

In the lower part of Buenaventura on 31/01 and at Milpe CR on 24/02.

Long-winged Antwren (*Myrmotherula longipennis*)

Along the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 14/02.

Gray Antwren (*Myrmotherula menetriesii*)

Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15 & 16/02.

Dot-winged Antwren (*Microrhopias quixensis*)

At Canande on 28/02 and 01/03.

Dugand's Antwren (*Herpsilochmus dugandi*)

From the road at Gareno on 14 & 15/02.

Yellow-breasted Antwren (*Herpsilochmus axillaris*)

On the trail at Bombuscaro 23/01, the old Loja/Zamora Rd on 24/01, inside the forest at the Loreto Rd on 12/02.

Long-tailed Antbird (*Drymophila caudata*)

On the Sendero Arturo Leon at Tapichalaca 26/01 and Snake Valley Trail at Septimo Paraiso on 22/02.

Striated Antbird (*Drymophila devillei*)

Inside the forest at El Para on 13/02.

Chestnut-shouldered Antwren (*Terenura humeralis*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 16/02.

Gray Antbird (*Cercomacra cinerascens*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15/02

Dusky Antbird (*Cercomacra tyrannina*)

Along the main road at Yalare Reserve on 26/02.

Blackish Antbird (*Cercomacra nigrescens*)

The lower part of the old Loja/Zamora Rd. on 24/01.

Black Antbird (*Cercomacra serva*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15/02

Jet Antbird (*Cercomacra nigricana*) H.

Within a couple of metres in the insect ridden mangrove forest near Manglares Churute on 02/02. it remained resolutely hidden.

White-browed Antbird (*Myrmoborus leucophrys*)

The lower part of the old Loja/Zamora Rd. on 24/01.

Black-faced Antbird (*Myrmoborus myotherinus*)

Inside the forest at El Para on 13/02.

Warbling Antbird (*Hypocnemis cantator*)

In the scrub at the entrance to El Para on 13/02.

Yellow-browed Antbird (*Hypocnemis hypoxantha*)

Seen daily at Garenó 14-16/02.

Scale-backed Antbird (*Hypocnemis poecilonota*)

A pair seen at a small antswarm off the Main Trail at Garenó on 14/02.

Spot-winged Antbird (*Shistocichla leucostigma*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Garenó on 15/02.

White-backed Fire-eye (*Pyriglena leuconota*)

On the Guacamayos Ridge on 09/02.

Grey-headed Antbird (*Myrmeciza griseiceps*) **Vulnerable**

On the Hanne Blocker Trail at Utuana on 28/01.

Sooty Antbird (*Myrmeciza fortis*)

With Scale-backed and White-plumed at the antswarm at Garenó on 14/02

Immaculate Antbird (*Myrmeciza immaculata*)

At Buenaventura on the Perio de Orces Trail on 31/01 and the Tapaculo Trail on 02/02, from the hide at Tandayapa Lodge on 18/02, Septimo Paraiso 22/02 and daily at Canande.

Chestnut-backed Antbird (*Myrmeciza exsul*)

Along the road at Yalare on 26/02 and then daily at Canande.

Esmeraldas Antbird (*Myrmeciza nigricauda*)

In the forest at Milpe CR on 23/02.

White-plumed Antbird (*Pithys albifrons*)

3 or 4 of these extraordinary, but very wary, birds seen at a small antswarm somewhere off the Main Trail over the stream at the lodge at Canande on 14/02. One of the highlights of the trip. We tried to relocate the antswarm later in the day, which we did but could see no bird activity.

Bicolored Antbird (*Gymnopithys leucaspis*)

3 or 4 seen at a small antswarm half way up the Main Trail at Canande on 28/02. The birds were active darting after prey but the steep, difficult terrain and thick undergrowth meant it took some while to see this highly skulking species properly.

Ocellated Antbird (*Phaenostictus mcleannani*)

Two birds seen very well but with some difficulty at a small antswarm half way up the Main Trail at Canande on 28/02. The birds were active darting after prey but the steep, difficult terrain and thick undergrowth meant it took some while to see this highly skulking species properly. One of the highlights of the trip.

ANTPITTAS & ANTTHRUSHES: FORMICARIIDAE

Black-faced Antthrush (*Formicarius analis*) H.

Heard on the Minihiva and Harpy Eagle Trails at Garenó on 14&15/02.

Black-headed Antthrush (*Formicarius nigricapillus*)

On the Botrosa Rd and Manakin Trail at Canande on 02&03/03.

Rufous-breasted Antthrush (*Formicarius rufipectus*)

Seen inside the forest on the Rd on 12/02.

Short-tailed Antthrush (*Chamaeza campanisona*)

Heard inside the forest at the Loreto Rd. on 11 & 12/02 but not pursued.

Striated Antthrush (*Chamaeza nobilis*)

Seen at Gareno on 14/02 near the antswarm in the late afternoon.

Barred Antthrush (*Chamaeza mollissima*) H.

Very, very close in response to tape inside the forest at Guacamayos Ridge on 10/02 but, sadly, remained unseen.

Giant Antpitta (*Grallaria gigantea*) **Vulnerable**

“María” one of the habituated antpittas seen at the extraordinary Angel Paz Refugio on 21/02.

Undulated Antpitta (*Grallaria squamigera*) H.

Heard on 4 dates, Cajanuma 24/01, the Hanne Blocker Trail at Utuana 28/01, and Yanacocha 03&04/02. Birds were either too far off or unresponsive.

Scaled Antpitta (*Grallaria guatemalensis*)

Heard a couple of times and finally seen after considerable effort in the upper part of Buenaventura on 01/02

Moustached Antpitta (*Grallaria alleni*). **Vulnerable**

We tried, unsuccessfully, for 2 hours to see this species on the Guacamayos Ridge on 09/02 before finally seeing it at the Angel Paz Refugio on 21/02.

Plain-backed Antpitta (*Grallaria haplonota*)

The so called “invisible antpitta” seen in the depths of the bug ridden forest after we bushwhacked well off the trail at the Loreto Rd on 12/02.

Chestnut-crowned Antpitta (*Grallaria ruficapilla*)

Heard on a number of occasions before being seen at Guango at dusk on 06/02, near the cabins at San Isidro on 07/02 and on the trail right by the lodge at Bellavista on 20/02.

Watkin’s Antpitta (*Grallaria watkinsii*)

After some time eventually seen well at the beginning of Trail 4 at Jorupe on 29/01.

JOCOTOCO ANTPITTA (*Grallaria ridgelyi*) H. **Endemic Endangered**

The ultimate frustration of the trip. In shocking weather we walked to the top of the Sendero Arturo Leon on 26/01 where we heard the bird but could not tape in. Later that day we walked down the main road and cut our own trail into the hillside where the bird came in silently to the tape, LN apparently glimpsing it. Tried this spot the following day when again a shadow was seen by MW but we no tickable views obtained.

Chestnut-naped Antpitta (*Grallaria nuchalis*) H.

Heard far off or in inaccessible terrain at Cajanuma, Tapachilaca and other locations in the south; the only possible chance was a bird calling near the start of the Manakin Trail at Canande on 28/02 which proved unresponsive.

White-bellied Antpitta (*Grallaria hypoleuca*)

One of the habituated, although still quite shy, birds seen at San Isidro on 07/02.

Yellow-breasted Antpitta (*Grallaria flavorincta*)

“Willy” one of the habituated antpittas seen at the extraordinary Angel Paz Refugio on 21/02.

Rufous Antpitta (*Grallaria rufula*)

Inside the forest at 4.5 km over the summit on the Gualaceo/Limon Rd 20/01, on the Water Tank trail at Cajanuma on 24/01 and at Tapichalaca on 26&27/01.

Tawny Antpitta (*Grallaria quitensis*)

At CajasNP on 18/01, Papallacta 05/02.

White-lored Antpitta (*Hypopezus fulviventris*)

In the scrub before the forest at El Para on 13/02.

Thrush-like Antpitta (*Myrmothera campanisona*) H

Heard daily at Gareno but not pursued.

Ochre-breasted Antpitta (*Grallaricula flavirostris*)

A pair seen on the Potoo Trail above Tandayapa Lodge 18/02.

Slate-crowned Antpitta (*Grallaricula nana*)

On the Antpitta Trail at Tapichalaca 25/01.

Rusty-breasted Antpitta (*Grallaricula ferruginepectus*)

In the Pululaua Valley on the old road to Nebli on 17/02.

Crescent-faced Antpitta (*Grallaricula lineigrons*) **Near-threatened**

Another torment. This much wanted bird located at 4.5km over the summit on Gualaceo/Limon Rd. on 20/01 initially proved responsive coming within a couple of metres inside the forest but remained hidden, then shut up, disappeared never to be located again.

TAPACULOS: RHINOCRYPTIDAE

Elegant Crescent-chest (*Melanoparcia elegans*)

West of Macara at the checkpoint at Catacocha turned uphill on the road to Celica and the bird was seen a couple of kms further on on 30/01.

Ash-colored Tapaculo (*Myornis senilis*)

Along the road 2-3kms over the summit of the Gualaceo/Limon Rd on 20/02

Blackish Tapaculo (*Scytalopus unicolor latrans*)

Heard often throughout Ecuador except in the north west and seen at Yanacocha on 03&04/02.

Equatorial Rufous-vented Tapaculo (*Scytalopus micropterus*)

On the Macucoloma Trail at San Isidro on 08/02.

Nariño Tapaculo (*Scytalopus vicinor*)

In the upper Tandayapa Valley on 19-21/02.

El Oro Tapaculo (*Scytalopus robbinsi*)

Heard close by on the Tapaculo Trail at Buenaventura on 02/02 but unresponsive.

Spillman's Tapaculo (*Scytalopus spillmannii*)

Seen on 17-21/02 in the Tandayapa Valley.

CHUSQUEA TAPACULO (*Scytalopus parkeri*) **Endemic**

Beyond the summit on the Gualaceo/Limon Rd on 20/01 and at Cajanuma on 22/01.

Paramo Tapaculo (*Scytalopus canus*)

Beyond the summit on the Gualaceo/Limon Rd on 20/01.

Ocellated Tapaculo (*Acropternis orthonyx*)

Heard distantly and frustratingly at Yanacocha and the Guacamayos Ridge this star bird finally seen on 2 dates in scrub and forest edge above Bellavista on 19&20/02.

TYRANTS FLYCATCHERS: TYRANNIDAE

Sooty-headed Tyrannulet (*Phyllomyias griseiceps*)

On the track near Cabanas Copalinga on 24/01.

Black-capped Tyrannulet (*Phyllomyias nigrocapillus*)

On the Gualaceo/Limon Rd. 20/01 and Yanacocha on 04/02.

Ashy-headed Tyrannulet (*Phyllomyias cinereiceps*)

Seen on the Guacamayos Ridge on 09&10/02 and around Milpe CR 22&23/02.

Tawny-rumped Tyrannulet (*Phyllomyias urupygialis*)

On the Hanne Blocker Trail at Utuana on 28/01.

Golden-faced Tyrannulet (*Zimmerius chrysops*)

Recorded on 10+ dates throughout the trip e.g. Bombuscaro, Rd., Gareno and Canande.

Loja Tyrannulet (*Zimmerius flavidifrons*)

Seen from the road below Utuana on 28/01, and Buenaventura 31/01 and 01/02.

Brown-capped Tyrannulet (*Ornithion brunneicapillum*)

At Yalare 26/02 and Canande on 28/02 and 02/03.

Southern Beardless Tyrannulet (*Camptostoma obsoletum*)

Heard often and seen on 10+ dates, e.g. Yunguilla, Tapichalaca, Jorupe and Canande.

Tumbesian Tyrannulet (*Phaeomyias tumbezana*)

Along the road between Utuana and Sozorango on 28/01.

Yellow-crowned Tyrannulet (*Tyrannulus elatus*)

At the lodge at Copalinga on 24/01.

Foothill Elaenia (*Myiopagis olallai*) **Near-threatened**

Along the road lower down the valley below the Loreto Rd on 12/02

Pacific Elaenia (*Myiopagis sunplacen*)

At Jorupe on Trail 4 on 29/01, and at Buenaventura on 30/01.

Greenish Elaenia (*Myiopagis viridicata*)

In the mangrove forest near Manglares Churute on 02/02.

Yellow-bellied Elaenia (*Elaenia flavofaster*)

In the valley below Tapichalaca on 26/01 and Yalare on 27/02.

Mottle-backed Elaenia (*Elaenia gigas*)

At Cabanas Copalinga on 22/01, the airstrip at Zamora on 23/01 and in the valley below Tapachilaca on 26/01.

Lesser Elaenia (*Elaenia chiriquensis*)

Along the road to Los Colibris near Mindo on 22/02.

White-crested Elaenia (*Elaenia albiceps*)

On the Gualaceo/Limon Rd on 20/01, the road to Hanne Blocke Trail at Utuana on 28/01 and Coyuja Forest near Guango on 07/02.

Sierran Elaenia (*Elaenia pallatangae*)

On the Gualaceo/Limon Rd on 20/01.

White-throated Tyrannulet (*Mecocerculus leucophrys*)

On the Gualaceo/Limon Rd on 20/01 and Yanacocha on 04/02.

White-banded Tyrannulet (*Mecocerculus stictopterus*)

On the Gualaceo/Limon Rd on 20/01, at Cajanuma 22/01, near Tapichalaca 27/01 Yanacocha 04/02, Chilpe River Trail at Guango 06 & 07/02.

White-tailed Tyrannulet (*Mecocerculus poecilocercus*)

Seen on 10 dates eg. Tapichalaca, San Isidro, Guacamayos Ridge, upper Tandayapa Valley.

Rufous-winged Tyrannulet (*Mecocerculus calopterus*)

On 19/01 at Yunguilla.

Sulphur-bellied Tyrannulet (*Mecocerculus minor*)

At San Isidro on the Macucoloma Trail 08/02 and the Guacamayos Ridge on 09/02.

This stunning species seen on the Hanne Blocker Trail at Utuana on 28/01.

Agile Tit-tyrant (*Uromyias agilis*)

On the trail behind the Termas de Papallacta on 05/02.

Tawny-crowned Pygmy-tyrant (*Eucarthmus meloryphus*)

Catamayo Airport scrub 27/01, the Zapotillo Rd. on 28&29/01 and near Catacocha on 30/01.

Streak-necked Flycatcher (*Mionectes striaticollis*)

At Cajanuma on 22/01, Guacamayos Ridge 09/02, Tandayapa Valley 19&20/02.

Olive-striped Flycatcher (*Mionectes olivaceus*)

On the Umberellabird Trail at Buenaventura on 31/01, Milpe CR on 23/02, Yalare on 26&27/02 and Canande 01&02/03.

Ochre-bellied Flycatcher (*Mionectes oleagineus*)

Minihiva and Harpy Eagle Trails at Gareno on 14&15/02 and Canande 02/03.

Slaty-capped Flycatcher (*Leptopogon superciliosus*)

Recorded on 10 + dates throughout the trip. e.g. Bombuscaro, Buenaventura, Rd, Milpe CR and Canande.

Ecuadorian Tyrannulet (*Phylloscartes gualaquiza*)

At Buenaventura on 31/01 on the Perio de Orces Trail.

Rufous-headed Pygmy-tyrant (*Pseudotriccus ruficeps*)

Near the hide at Tapichalaca on 26/01 and on the Guacamayos Ridge 09&10/02.

Black-capped Pygmy-tyrant (*Myiornis atricapillus*)

On 26/02 on the Concepcion Rd at Yalare Reserve and at Canande 02/03.

Scale-crested Pygmy-tyrant (*Lophotriccus pileatus*)

Daily at Buenaventura 31/01-02/02, and around Milpe CR and Mindo 22-24/02.

Double-banded Pygmy-tyrant (*Lophotriccus vitiensis*)

On the Minihiva Trail at Gareno on 14/02.

White-eyed Tody-tyrant (*Hermitriccus zosterops*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15/02.

Rufous-crowned Tody-tyrant (*Poecilotriccus ruficeps*)

On 08/02 along the road at San Isidro.

Black & White Tody-tyrant (*Poecilatriccus capitalis*)

Inside the forest at El Para on 13/02.

Golden-winged Tody-flycatcher (*Poecilatriccus calapterum*)

At Cabanas Copalinga on 22&23/01.

Black-headed Tody-flycatcher (*Todirostrum nigriceps*)

On the Main Trail at Canande on 28/02 and the Botrosa Rd on 02/03.

Common Tody-flycatcher (*Todirostrum cinerum*)

Recorded regularly (10+dates) on the trip. eg Tapichalaca, Jorupe, Milpe CR and Canande.

Olivaceous Flatbill (*Rhynchocyclus olivaceus*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 16/02.

Yellow-olive Flatbill (*Tolmomyias sulphurescens*)

On 23/01 at Bombuscaro after the rain, the Loja/Zamora Rd 24/01, Trail 4 Jorupe 29/01.

Ruddy-tailed Flycatcher (*Terenotriccus erythrus*)

On 14/02 on the Minihiva Trail at Gareno and the Manakin Trail at Canande on 01/03.

Whiskered Flycatcher (*Myiobius babatus*)

On the Minihiva Trail at Gareno on 14/02.

Sulphur-rumped Flycatcher (*Myiobius sulphureipygius*)

At Buenaventura on 31/01 and 01/02.

Tawny-breasted Flycatcher (*Myiobius villosus*)

On 24/02 at Milpe CR.

Flavescent Flycatcher (*Myiophobus flavicand*)

On the Macculoma Trail at San Isidro on 08/02 and the Tandayapa Valley on 20/02.

Bran-colored Flycatcher (*Myiophobus fasciatus*)

At Yunguilla on 19/01, en route to Vilcabamaba and Buenaventura 31/01.

Olive-chested Flycatcher (*Myiophobus cryptoxanthus*)

At Cabanas Copalinga on 22/01 and the Loreto Road on 11/02.

Handsome Flycatcher (*Myiophobus pulcher*)

On the Guacamayos Ridge on 09&10/02.

Orange-banded Flycatcher (*Myiophobus lintoni*) **Near-threatened**

From the car park at Cajanuma on 22/01.

Cinnamon Flycatcher (*Pyrrhomyias cinamomea*)

At the Uzhpud Hotel 19/01, Cajanuma 22/01, Tapichalaca 26/01, Guacamayos Ridge 10/02 and the Tandayapa Valley 19&20/02.

Common (Tufted) Flycatcher (*Mitrephanes phaeocercus*)

At Canande Reserve on the Mirador Trail on 01/03 and the Botrosa Road 02/03.

Eastern Wood-Pewee (*Contopus virens*)

Cabanas Copalinga 23/01, the Loreto Rd 11&12/02 El Para 13/02 and at Gareno 14/02.

Western Wood-Pewee (*Contopus sordidulus*)

At Milpe CR on 23/02.

Tumbes Pewee (*Contopus punensis*)

On the road to Celica up from the checkpoint at Catacocha on the Macara – Loja road 30/01.

Smoke-coloured Pewee (*Contopus fumigatus*)

Seen on 10 dates, e.g. Sozorango, Buenaventura, Guango, Tandayapa Valley and Milpe CR.

Olive-sided Flycatcher (*Contopus cooperi*) **Near-threatened**

On 29/01 on the main trail at Jorupe.

Black Phoebe (*Sayornis nigricans*)

At a stream on the old Loja/Zamora Rd on 24/01.

Vermillion Flycatcher (*Pyrocephalus rubinus*)

Hosteria Agua y Sol near Yunguilla on 18&19/01 and Catamayo scrub on 27/01.

Brown-backed Chat-Tyrant (*Ochthoeca fumicolor*)

At Cajas NP on 18/01 and Cayamba Coca Reserve at Papallacta on 05/02

Rufous-breasted Chat-Tyrant (*Ochthoeca rufipectoralis*)

On the Gualaceo/Limon Rd on 21/01.

Slaty-backed Chat-Tyrant (*Ochthoeca cinnamomeiventris*)

At Cajanuma on 24/01.

Crowned Chat-Tyrant (*Ochthoeca frontalis*)

On the Gualaceo/Limon Rd on 20&21/01.

Jelski's Chat-Tyrant (*Ochthoeca jelskii*)

From the road below Utuana on 28/01.

Yellow-bellied Chat-Tyrant (*Ochthoeca diadema*)

On the short trail by the hide at Tapichalaca on 26/01.

Red-rumped Bush-Tyrant (*Cnemarchus erythropygius*)

In the open country below the lower part of the Gualaceo/Limon Rd. on 21/01.

Streak-throated Bush-Tyrant (*Myiotheretes striaticollis*)

At Cajanuma on 22/01.

Smoky Bush-Tyrant (*Myiotheretes fumigatus*)

At Cajanuma on 22/01 and Yanacocha on 03/02.

Cliff Flycatcher (*Hirundinea ferruginea*)

On the cliffs beyond the entrance to the forest at the Loreto Road on 11&12/02.

Black-billed Shrike-Tyrant (*Agriornis montana*)

At Lake Toreadora at Cajas NP on 18/01.

White-tailed Shrike-Tyrant (*Agriornis andicola*) **Vulnerable**

In the Equator Line Valley near Quito on 17/02.

Paramo Ground-Tyrant (*Muscisaxicola alpina*)

Above the radio station at the summit of the Papallacta Pass, 4150masl, on 05/02.

Long-tailed Tyrant (*Colonia colunus*)

At Yalare on 26/02 and Canande 28/02-02/03.

Masked Water-Tyrant (*Fluvicola nengeta*)

At a garage near Milpe CR on 23/02 and at Rio Verde 27/02 on the road to Esmeraldas.

Bright-rumped Attila (*Attila spadiceus*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15/02.

Ochraceous Attila (*Attila torridus*) **Vulnerable**

At the beginning of the Umbrellabird Trail at Buenaventura on 31/01.

Rufous Mourner (*Rhytipterna holerythra*)

On the road to Concepcion at Yalare on 27/02.

Western Sirystes (*Sirystes albogriseus*)

On the road to Concepcion at Yalare on 26&27/02.

Dusky-capped Flycatcher (*Myiarchus tuberculifer*)

Seen on 10 dates e.g Yunguilla, Buenaventura and Milpe CR.

Pale-edged Flycatcher (*Myiarchus cephalotes*)

On the road and on the Macculoma Trail at San Isidro on 07&08/02.

Sooty-crowned Flycatcher (*Myiarchus phaeocephalus*)

On the Zapotillo Road on 29/01 and on the road to Catacocha on 30/01.

Boat-billed Flycatcher (*Megarhynchus pitagua*)

At Jorupe on 29/01, Guacamayos Ridge on 10/02, Tundaloma 25/02 and Yalare 26/02.

Social Flycatcher (*Myiozetetes similis*)

Common seen on 15+dates throughout the trip.

Rusty-margined Flycatcher (*Myiozetetes cayanensis*)

Common in the northwest; seen daily from Mindo to Canande.

Gray-capped Flycatcher (*Myiozetetes granadensis*)

By the stream at the entrance to El Para 13/02, and at Gareno 14/02.

Dusky-chested Flycatcher (*Myiozetetes luteiventris*)

In the upper Tandayapa Valley on 20/02.

Lemon-browed Flycatcher (*Conopias cinchoneti*)

On the old Loja/Zamora Rd on 24/01 and at Gareno on 14/02.

White-ringed Flycatcher (*Conopias albovittata*)

On 27/02 on the road to Concepcion at Yalare.

Streaked Flycatcher (*Myiodnastes maculatus*)

At Jorupe Reserve on Trail 4 on 29/01.

Sulphur-bellied Flycatcher (*Myiodnastes luteiventris*)

At the bridge over the Rio Nuschinipar at Gareno on 15/02.

Baird's Flycatcher (*Myiodnastes bairdii*)

In a dry gully on the road west of Macara on 30/01.

Golden-crowned Flycatcher (*Myiodnastes chysocephalus*)

At Bombuscaro on 23/01, the Tandayapa Valley on 18-20/02.

Piratic Flycatcher (*Legatus leocuphaius*)

The Zamora airstrip 23/01, Buenaventura 31/01, the Loreto Rd 11/02 and Yalare 26&27/02.

Sulphury Flycatcher (*Tyrannopsis sulphurca*)

On 13/02 on a small un-named road off the road from Archidona – Gareno.

Tropical Kingbird (*Tyrannus melancholicus*)

Common; seen throughout the trip.

Yellow-cheeked Becard (*Pachyramphus xanthogenys*)

In the valley below Tapichalaca on 26/01.

Barred Becard (*Pachyramphus spodiurus*)

Far over the east side of the Gualaceo/Limon Rd on 20/01, San Isidro 08/02 and the Guacamayos Ridge on 09&10/02.

Slaty Becard (*Pachyramphus spodiurus*) **Endangered**

In the dry forest on the main trail at Jorupe on 29/01.

Chestnut-crowned Becard (*Pachyramphus castaneus*)

On a small un-named side road en route to Gareno from Tena on 13/02.

Cinnamon Becard (*Pachyramphus cinnamomeus*)

Along the track to the lower entrance to Buenaventura 30/01, and commonly thereafter at Mindo, Yalare & Canande.

White-winged Becard (*Pachyramphus polychopterus*)

At El Para on 13/02 and a female at Tundaloma on 25/02.

Black and white Becard (*Pachyramphus albogriseus*)

In the dry forest on the main trail at Jorupe on 29/01 and Guacamayos Ridge 09/02.

One-colored Becard (*Platypsaris homochrous*)

On the Zapotillo Rd on 28/01 and at Jorupe on 29/01.

Pink-throated Becard (*Platypsaris minor*)

A female on the main road at Gareno on 25/02.

Black-tailed Tityra (*Tityra cayana*)

At Gareno on 14&15/02.

Masked Tityra (*Tityra semifasciata*)

The old Loja/Zamora Rd on 24/02, the Loreto Rd. 12/02, Tundaloma 25/02, Yalare 27/02 and Canande 02/03.

Black-crowned Tityra (*Tityra inquisitor*)

On 25/02 at Tundaloma and at Canande on 02/03.

COTINGAS: COTINGIDAE

Red-crested Cotinga (*Ampelion rubrocristatus*)

Poorly seen in descending cloud on the Hanne Blocker Trail at Utuana on 28/01.

Barred Fruiteater (*Pipreola arcuata*)

A female along the Gualaceo/Limon Rd on 20/01 and a male at Yanacocha on 04/02.

Green-and-black Fruiteater (*Pipreola riefferii*)

A female in the valley below Tapichalaca on 27/01, a male on the Guacamayos Ridge 09/02 and another female on the HT trail at Bellavista in the upper Tandayapa Valley 19/02.

Black-chested Fruiteater (*Pipreola lubomirskii*)

A pair along the road around San Isidro on 08/02.

Orange-breasted Fruiteater (*Pipreola jucunda*)

Female seen well but poor view of the male on a trail behind Mindo Loma 21/02.

Scaled Fruiteater (*Amphelioides tschdii*)

In the upper part of Buenaventura on the Zambotambo road on 01/02 and at Angel Paz 21/02.

Cinereous Mourner (*Laniocera hypopyrra*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15/02.

Olivaceous Piha (*Lipaugis cryptolophus*)

On the Guacamayos Ridge on 09&10/02

Screaming Piha (*Lipaugis vociferans*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15/02. Heard on several other occasions.

Rufous Piha (*Lipaugis unirufus*)

On the Mirador Trail at Canande 28/02.

Blue Cotinga (*Continga natteretti*)

Scope views from the lodge at Tundaloma on 25/02.

Spangled Cotinga (*Continga cayana*)

On the main road at Gareno on 14/02.

Black-tipped Cotinga (*Carpodetes hopkii*)

Along the road from the lodge at Canande towards the ferry at Rio Canande on 01/03

Purple-throated Fruitcrow (*Querula purpurata*)

From the road at Gareno on 14&15/02.

Amazonian Umbrellabird (*Cephalopterus ornatus*)

3 or 4 birds at Bombuscarao on 23/01.

Long-wattled Umbrellabird (*Cephalopterus penduliger*) **Vulnerable**

This fantastic species at a lek on the aptly named Umbrellabird Trail at Buenaventura on 31/01

Andean Cock-of-the-rock (*Rupicola peruviana*)

At Bombuscaro 23/01 and a female on the old Loja/Zamora Rd on 24/01, the Guacamayos Ridge 09/02 and 5 or 6 of this fantastic species at the lek at Angel Paz Refugio on 23/02.

MANAKINS: PIPRIDAE

Golden-headed Manakin (*Pipra erythrocephala*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15/02.

Red-capped Manakin (*Pipra mentalis*)

At Canande on the Manakin Trail on 01/03.

Blue-crowned Manakin (*Lepidothrix coronada*)

On the road and the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 14&15/02. and Canande on 02/03.

Blue-rumped Manakin (*Lepidothrix isidorei*)

Inside the forest at the Loreto Rd on 11&12/02

Blue-backed Manakin (*Chiroxiphia pareola*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 16/02.

Golden-winged Manakin (*Masius chysopterus*)

Inside the forest at Loreto Rd 11&12/02, the Snake Valley Trail at Septimo Paraiso 22/02.

White-bearded Manakin (*Manacus manacus*)

At Yalare on 26/02 and Canande on 27/02 – 02/03.

Club-winged Manakin (*Manacus deliciosus*)

On the lower part of the trail at Buenaventura on 31/01 and Milpe CR 23&24/02

Green Manakin (*Chloropipo holochlora*)

Along the road at Canande on 01/03.

Dwarf Tyrant Manakin (*Turanneutes stolzmanni*)

On the Main Trail at Gareno on 14/02.

JAYS: CORVIDAE

Turquoise Jay (*Cyanolyca turcosa*)

Recorded regularly (10+ dates) throughout the trip. e.g. Gualaceo/Limon Rd., old Loja Zamora Rd., Guango, San Isidro, Tandayapa Valley.

Violaceous Jay (*Cyanocorax violaceus*)

On the Loreto Rd 11/02 and at Gareno 13-15/02.

White-tailed Jay (*Cyanocorax mystacalis*)

On the Zapotillo Rd 28/01 and the main trail at Jorupe 29/01/01.

Inca Jay (*Cyanocorax yncas*)

At Bombuscaro on 23/01, old Loja/Zamora Rd 24/01, Guango 06/02, San Isidro 08/02.

VIREOS: VIREONIDAE

Rufous-browed Peppershrike (*Cyclarhis gujanensis*)

Heard regularly in the south and seen at the Hosteria Sol y Agua on 19/11 and in the valley below Tapichalaca on 26/01.

Black-billed Peppershrike (*Cyclarhis nigrirostris*)

On 08/02 along the road at San Isidro.

Slaty-capped Shrike-vireo (*Vireolanus leucotis*)

Inside the forest at the Loreto Rd on 11/02.

Red-eyed Vireo (*Vireo olivaceus*)

In the valley below Tapichalaca on 26/01, Jorupe 29/01 and on the road to Catacocha 30/01.

Yellow-green Vireo (*Vireo flavoviridis*)

Inside the forest at El Para on 13/02.

Brown-capped Vireo (*Vireo leucophrys*)

Common, seen regularly throughout the trip.

Dusky-capped Greenlet (*Hylophilus hypoxanthus*)

On the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15/02.

Lesser Greenlet (*Hylophilus decurtatus*)

At Buenaventura on 30/01 and 01&02/02.

Olivaceous Greenlet (*Hylophilus olivaceus*)

At Cabanas Copalinga on 24/01 and in the valley below Tapichalaca on 26/01.

THRUSHES: TURDIDAE

Andean Solitaire (*Myadestes ralloides*)

On the Tapaculo Trail at Buenaventura on 02/02, at San Isidro on 07&08/02.

Slaty-backed Nightingale-Thrush (*Catharus fuscater*)

Seen at Yunguilla on 19/01; heard a number of times thereafter.

Swainson's Thrush (*Catharus ustulatus*)

Common, seen regularly throughout the trip.

Pale-eyed Thrush (*Platycichla leucops*)

On 08/02 at San Isidro.

Chiguanco Thrush (*Turdus chiguanco*)

On the Gualaceo/Limon Rd on 20/01.

Great Thrush (*Turdus fuscater*)

Common, seen regularly throughout the trip.

Glossy-black Thrush (*Turdus serranus*)

The Gualaceo/Limon Rd 19/01, in the valley below Tapichalaca 26/01, San Isidro 07&08/02 and the Guacamayos Ridge 09&10/02.

Chestnut-bellied Thrush (*Turdus fulviventris*)

On the Guacamayos Ridge on 09&10/02.

Plumbeous-backed Thrush (*Turdus reevei*)

On the Zapotillo Rd on 28&29/01 and on the road from Macara to Catacocha on 30/01.

Marañon Thrush (*Turdus maranonicus*)

In the valley below Tapichalaca 26/01.

Black-billed Thrush (*Turdus ignobilis*)

On 22/01 at Cabanas Copalinga, Zamora airstrip 23/01, in the valley below Tapichalaca 26/01 and San Isidro on 08/02.

Lawrence's Thrush (*Turdus lawrencii*) H.

Heard regularly on the Harpy Eagle Trail at Gareno on 15&16/02.

Pale-vented Thrush (*Turdus obsoletus*)

At Milpe CR on 24/02.

Ecuadorian Thrush (*Turdus maculirostris*)

On 28/01 on the road from Utuana – Sozarango, Buenaventura on 01&02/02, Milpe CR 23/02 and near Esmeraldas Airport 27/02.

White-necked Thrush (*Turdus albicollis*)

At Bombuscaro on 23/01 and on the Minihiva Trail at Gareno on 14/02

Dagua Thrush (*Turdus daguae*)

At the upper end of the Botrosa Rd. at Canande on 02/03.

Andean Slaty-thrush (*Turdus nigriceps*)

From the road below Utuana on 28/01.

MOCKINGBIRDS: MIMIDAE

Long-tailed Mockingbird (*Mimus longicaudatus*)

Only in the south; in the Catamayo Airport scrub on 27/01, on the road between Utuana and Sozorango 28/01, Zapotillo Rd 29/01 and on the road to Catacocha 30/01.

Tropical Mockingbird (*Mimus gilvus*)

Along the road between Ibarra and El Limonal on the road to San Lorenzo on 25/02.

DIPPERS: CINCLIDAE

White-capped Dipper (*Cinclus leucocephalus*)

A pair in the river below the EERSA hydro plant between Loja and Zamora on 22/01, at Guango 07/02 and in a stream on the road to Mariposa de Mindo on 22/02.

SWALLOWS & MARTINS: HIRUNDINIDAE

Gray-breasted Martin (*Progne chalybea*)

Seen regularly in the south on 8 dates but only 2 dates thereafter.

Brown-bellied Swallow (*Notiochelidon murina*)

Over the Gulaceo/Limon Rd on 20&21/01, Yanacocha 03&04/02 and Guango 07/02.

Blue-and-white Swallow (*Notiochelidon cyanoleuca*)

Very common seen daily.

Pale-footed Swallow (*Notiochelidon flavipes*)

Seen on 24/01 at Cajanuma.

White-banded Swallow (*Atticora fasciata*)

At Cabanas Copalinga 22&23/01 and over Garenno on 16/02.

White-thighed Swallow (*Neochelidon tibialis*)

Seen on 8 dates e.g. the Loreto Rd 12&13/02, Milpe CR 23&24/02 and Canande 01&02/03.

Southern Rough-winged Swallow (*Stelgidopteryx ruficollis*)

Recorded on 10 dates; e.g. Bombuscaro 23/01, Mindo 23&24/02 and Canande 01&02/03.

Barn Swallow (*Hirundo rustica*)

Along the road on 2 dates 02/02 and 26/02.

Chestnut-collared Swallow (*Petrochelidon rufocollaris*)

Communally nesting in the old church in Sozorango on 28/01.

WRENS: TROGLODYTIDAE

Black-capped Donacobius (*Donacobius atrocapillus*)

In the marshy land at the Zamora airstrip on 23/01 and the road from Tena – Garenno 13/02

Band-backed Wren (*Campyloryhnchus zonatus*)

At Canande on 01&02/03.

Fasciated Wren (*Campyloryhnchus fasciatus*)

Recorded daily in the south 27/01 31/01 at Tapichalaca, Utuana, Buenaventura.

Wing-banded Wren (*Microcerculus bambla*)

Inside the forest at the Loreto Rd on 12/02.

Capped Conebill (*Conirostrum albifrons*)

Bluish Flowerpiercer (*Diglossopsis caerulea*)

At San Isidro on 07&08/02 and the Guacamayos Ridge 10/02.

Masked Flowerpiercer (*Diglossopsis cyanea*)

Common. Recorded regularly throughout the trip.

Golden-eyed Flowerpiercer (*Diglossopsis glauca*)

At Bombuscaro on 23/01, the Loreto Rd 11&12/02

Glossy Flowerpiercer (*Diglossa lafresnayii*)

At the summit of the Gualaceo/Limon road on 20/01, Cajanuma 22/01, Cerro Toledo 25/01, Yanacocha 03&04/02.

Black Flowerpiercer (*Diglossa humeralis*)

At Cajas NP on 18/01, Hosteria Sol y Agua 19/01.

White-sided Flowerpiercer (*Diglossa albilatera*)

On 21/01 near Huashapamba, Tapichalaca 26/01 and the Tandayapa Valley on 19&20/02 and Angel Paz 23/02.

Rusty Flowerpiercer (*Diglossa sittoides*)

In the Chiche River Valley above Quito on 05/02.

Guira Tanager (*Hemithraupis guira*)

Scarlet-and-white Tanager (*Erythrothlypis salmomi*)

After many hours searching finally seen on the Botrosa Rd. at Canande on 02/03.

Fawn-breasted Tanager (*Pipraeidea melanonota*)

At Yunguilla on 19/01, Buenaventura 01/02 and Milpe CR 23/02.

Blue-naped Chlorophonia (*Chlorophonia cyanea*)

Inside the forest at Loreto Rd. on 12/02.

Yellow-collared Chlorophonia (*Chlorophonia flavirostris*)

At Milpe CR on 23&24/02.

Chestnut-breasted Chlorophonia (*Chlorophonia pyrrhophrys*)

At Cajanuma on 22/01, Coyuja Forest near Guango 07/02 and Guacamayos Ridge on 10/02.

Bronze-green Euphonia (*Euphonia mesochrysa*)

On the Loreto Rd. on 11&12/02.

White-lored Euphonia (*Euphonia chrysopasta*)

On a small un-named road off the main road between Tena and Gareno on 13/02.

Orange-eared Tanager (*Chlorochrysa calliparaca*)

In the tanager flock after the rain at Bombuscaro 23/01, the Loja/Zamora Rd. 24/01, Guacamayos Ridge on 09/02 and the Loreto Rd. 12/02.

Rufous-throated Tanager (*Tangara rufigula*)

On 31/01 at Benaventura and Milpe CR. 23&24/02

Gray-and-gold Tanager (*Tangara palmeri*)

On 25/02 on the San Lorenzo Rd, and on the Mirador Trail at Canande 28/02.

Golden Tanager (*Tangara arthus*)

Common. This stunning tanager recorded regularly throughout the trip.

Emerald Tanager (*Tangara florida*)

On 25/02 on the San Lorenzo Rd. and Canande 28/02.

Silver-throated Tanager (*Tangara icterocephala*)

At Buenaventura on 31/01 & 01/02 and Milpe CR. 23&24/02.

Saffron-crowned Tanager (*Tangara xanthocephala*)

On 19/01 in the grounds of Hosteria Sol y Agua, on 27/01 at the Catamayo airport scrub, at the Chiche River Valley 05/02.

Lesser Seed-Finch (*Oryzoborus angolensis*)

At Bombuscaro 23/01, the old Loja/Zamora Rd. on 24/01 then at various roadside stops on 30/01, 02/02, the Guacamayos Ridge 10/02 and El Para 13/02.

Large-billed Seed-Finch (*Oryzoborus crassirostris*)

At the dis-used toll booth on the road to Guyaquil from Buenaventura on 02/02 and on the road to San Lorenzo 25/02.

Slate-coloured Seedeater (*Sporophila schistacea*)

This rare seedeater seen in the scrub by the ferry at Rio Canande on 27/02.

Caquetá Seedeater (*Sporophila murallae*)

On an un-named road off the road to Gareno from Tena on 13/02.

Variable Seedeater (*Sporophila corvina*)

At Buenaventura 30&31/01, on the road to Guyaquil on 02/02, Milpe CR. 22-24/02.

Black-and-white Seedeater (*Sporophila luctuosa*)

At Buenaventura 30/01, the Chiche River Valley 05/02 and at San Isidro 10/02

Yellow-bellied Seedeater (*Sporophila nigricollis*)

Recorded regularly throughout the trip.

Parrot-billed Seedeater (*Sporophila peruviana*)

At the shrimp ponds near Santa Rosa marsh on 02/02

Drab Seedeater (*Sporophila simplex*)

In open country near Esmeraldas on 27/02.

Chestnut-throated Seedeater (*Sporophila telasco*)

At the Santa Rosa marsh on 02/02 and near San Isidro on 10/02.

Ruddy-breasted Seedeater (*Sporophila minuta*)

Along the road between Ibarra and El Limonal on the road to San Lorenzo on 25/02.

Chestnut-bellied Seedeater (*Sporophila castaneiventris*)

In open country near Archidona 10/02 and on an un-named road off the road to Gareno from Tena on 13/02

Blue Seedeater (*Amaurospiza concolor*)

On the Snake Valley trail at Septimo Paraíso on 22/02.

Plain-coloured Seedeater (*Catamenia inornata*)

At Cajas NP on 18/01, and on the Gualaceo/Limon road on 21/01.

Paramo Seedeater (*Catamenia homochroa*)

At Cajanuma on 24/01 and at Cerro Toledo on 25/01.

Band-tailed Seedeater (*Catamenia analis*)

In the valley below Tapichalaca on 26/01, Chiche River Valley on 05/02 and in fields near the Nebli turnoff on 17/02.

Plumbeous Sierra-Finch (*Phrygilus unicolor*)

At Cajas NP on 18/01 and near the summit at Papallacta on 05/02.

Ash-breasted Sierra-Finch (*Phrygilus plebejus*)

On the road to Loja west of Macara on 30/01

Band-tailed Sierra-Finch (*Phrygilus alaudinus*)

In the fields above Nebli on the road from Quito to Tandayapa on 17/02

Saffron Finch (*Sicalis flaveola*)

Seen on 4 dates only in the south; Sozorango 28/01, the Zapotillo Road 29/01, the road to Celica 30/01 and the Santa Rosa marsh 02/02.

Grassland Yellow-Finch (*Sicalis luteola*)

At the Equator Line Valley on 17/02.

Slaty Finch (*Haplospiza rustica*)

At the entrance to Bombuscaro on 23/01.

Red Pileated-Finch (*Coryphospingus cucullatus*)

On 26/01 in the valley below Tapichalaca.

Pale-naped Brush-Finch (*Atlapetes pallidinucha*)

On the Gualaceo/Limon road on 20&21/01, Cerro Toledo 25/01 and Tapichalaca 26/01.

Rufous-naped Brush-Finch (*Atlapetes latinuchus*)

The Gualaceo/Limon road 20/01, Cajanuma 22&24/01, Tapichalaca 25-27/01 and Guango Lodge 07/02.

Choco (Tricoloured Brush-Finch) (*Atlapetes tricolor*)

In the Tandayapa Valley 18&19/02 and Milpe CR 24/02.

Slaty Brush-Finch (*Atlapetes schistaceus*)

On 06&07/02 at Guango Lodge.

White-winged Brush-Finch (*Atlapetes leucopterus*)

On the road from Utuana to Sozorango (1700m) 28/01, Zapotillo Rd 29/01, and the Tandayapa Valley 17&18/02.

Bay-crowned Brush-Finch (*Atlapetes seedohmi*)

From the road below Utuana on 27/01.

White-headed Brush-Finch (*Atlapetes albiceps*)

On the road to Catacocha west of Macara 30/01.

Pale-headed Brush-Finch (*Atlapetes pallidiceps*) **Endemic Critically Endangered**

Three of these extremely rare birds, long thought to be extinct, seen at Yunguilla on 19/01 where the population now stands at around 40 pairs.

Chestnut-capped Brush-Finch (*Bucarremon brunneinucha*)

At Tapichalaca 26&27/01 and the Tandayapa valley 18&20/02.

Stripe-headed Brush-Finch (*Bucarremon torquata*)

At Yunguilla 19/01, Gualaceo/Limon road on 20/01 and Buenaventura on the Perio de Orces Trail 31/01.

Olive Finch (*Lysurus castaneiceps*)

On the track leading to the entrance to Bombuscaro on 23/01.

Tanager Finch (*Oreothraupis arremonops*) **Vulnerable**

A small group of this uncommon species seen on the Main Road and then on the Research Road above Bellavista in the Tandayapa Valley on 20/02.

Orange-billed Sparrow (*Arremon aurantiitostriis*)

Copalinga 22&23/01, Buenaventura on 31/01.

Black-capped Sparrow (*Arremon abeillei*)

On Trail 4 at Jorupe on 29/01.

Black-striped Sparrow (*Arremonops conirostris*)

At Buenaventura 30&31/01 en route to San Lorenzo on 25/02.

Yellow-browed Sparrow (*Ammodramus aurifrons*)

Copalinga 22&23/01, Tapichalaca 26/01 and in the grounds of Orchid Paradise Hotel 13/02

Tumbes Sparrow (*Aimophila stolzmanni*)

In the scrub near Catamayo airport 27/01 on the road to Cariamanga.

Rufous-collared Sparrow (*Zonotrichia capensis*)

Recorded regularly throughout the trip.

Collared Warbling-Finch (*Poospiza hispaniolensis*)

A roadside stop between Catacocha and Balsas on 30/01.

NEW WORLD BLACKBIRDS & ORIOLES: ICTERIDAE

Yellow-rumped Cacique (*Cacicus cela*)

Seen on 10 dates e.g. On 23/01 at Bombuscaro, Jorupe 29/01, Buenaventura 31/01, the Loreto Road 11/02, Gareno 14/02.

Northern Mountain Cacique (*Cacicus leucoramphus*)

At the Coyuja Forest patch below Guango on 07/02.

Subtropical Cacique (*Cacicus uropygialis*)

On 24/01 on the old Loja/Zamora Rd and San Isidro 08/02.

Scarlet-rumped Cacique (*Cacicus microhynchus*)

High up the Mirador Trail at Canade on 28/02.

Yellow-billed Cacique (*Amblycercus holosericeus*)

On the Sendero Arturo Leon at Tapichalaca on 26/02.

Casqued Oropendola (*Clypicterus oseryi*)

At Gareno 15&16/02.

Crested Oropendola (*Psarocolius decumanus*)

Copalinga 22&23/01, and El Para 13/02.

Russet-backed Oropendola (*Psarocolius angustifrons*)

On the old Loja/Zamora Rd 24/01, Guango 06/02, San Isidro 07/02 and Loreto Rd 11/02.

Shiny Cowbird (*Molothrus bonariensis*)

Yunguilla 19/01, Jorupe 29/01, Buenaventura 31/01 and around Yalare 26&27/02

Scrub Blackbird (*Dives warszewiczi*)

Only in the south where seen daily from 25/01 Tapichalaca to Buenaventura 31/01.

Great-tailed Grackle (*Quiscalus mexicanus*)

On 02/02 at the shrimp ponds near Santa Rosa on the road to Guayaquil.

Orange-backed Troupial (*Icterus croconotus*)

From the Main Road at Garenno on 14/02

White-edge Oriole (*Icterus graceannae*)

On the Zapatillo Rd 28&29/01.

Yellow-tailed Oriole (*Icterus mesomelas*)

On the Zapatillo Rd on 29/01, Buenaventura 31/01 and the road near Esmeraldas on 27/02.

Red-breasted Blackbird (*Sturnella militaris*)

In open country along the road from Tena to Garenno on 13/02.

Peruvian Meadowlark (*Sturnella bellicosa*)

The grounds of Sol y Agua at Yunguilla 19/01 and the road near Santa Rosa Marsh 02/02

CARDULINAE FINCHES: FRINGILLIDAE

Hooded Siskin (*Carduelis magellanica*)

At Cajas NP 18/01, and a further 4 dates the south, then Chiche River Valley near Quito on 05/02 and on the road to San Lorenzo 25/02

Olivaceous Siskin (*Carduelis olivacea*)

In the valley below Tapichalaca on 26/01

Yellow-bellied Siskin (*Carduelis xanthrogastra*)

At Milpe CR on 23/02.

OLD WORLD SPARROWS: PASSERIDAE

House Sparrow (*Passer domesticus*)

Manged to avoid seeing this species until Day 41 at the ferry crossing over the Rio Canande on 27/02.
