AFRICAN SPOONBILL – S and a few at LR

LESSER FLAMINGO – c.20 at S

WHITE FACED WHISTLING DUCK – c.30 both near S and LR

BLACK SHOULDERED KITE – near S

BLACK KITE – MC; TBB and several near Mombasa

AFRICAN WHITE BACKED VULTURE – large group flying TE

AFRICAN PALM SWIFT – seen regularly
EURASIAN SWIFT – a few at SH
LITTLE SWIFT – nesting at V
SPECKLED MOUSEBIRD – TE; several near S
BLUE-NAPED MOUSEBIRD – c.10 TE
GREY-HEADED KINGFISHER – V; several along LR; SH
BROWN HOODED KINGFISHER – at least 3 at SH
MANGROVE KINGFISHER – TB; at least 4 at LR
STRIPED KINGFISHER - SH
MALACHITE KINGFISHER – near S; LR
PIED KINGFISHER – LR; TBB
EURASIAN BEE-EATER – seen flying over TB and MC
CARMINE BEE-EATER – 2 en route to hotel; c.50 LR
WHITE-THROATED BEE-EATER –c.10 TE ; several LR
LITTLE BEE-EATER – a few at V
SOMALI BEE-EATER – TE [partial view]
EURASIAN ROLLER - SH
LILAC-BREASTED ROLLER – several TE; LR
HOOPOE - TE
GREEN WOOD-HOOPOE – ASF; a few at LR
COMMON SCIMITARBILL – ASF both visits
RED-BILLED HORNBILL – seen regularly in Tsavo
VON DER DECKEN’S HORNBILL – several at Tsavo
CROWNED HORNBILL - SH
AFRICAN GREY HORNBILL – Seen in a few places
TRUMPETER HORNBILL - SH
SILVERY CHEEKED HORNBILL – several at SH

LESSER-STRIPED SWALLOW – a few at airport
AFRICAN PIED WAGTAIL – 2 at hotel most days; seen occasionally elsewhere
GOLDEN PIPIT – several at TE, near Sala Gate
GRASSLAND PIPIT – a few seen at several sites

MALINDI PIPIT – 2 at LR
SOKOKE PIPIT – 2 at ASF
YELLOW-THROATED LONGCLAW – TE; SH; LR
RED WINGED LARK -TE
ZANZIBAR SOMBRE GREENBUL - seen occasionally near coast
YELLOW BELLIED GREENBUL – seen a few times at ASF; SH
COMMON BULBUL – Everywhere!
LITTLE BULBUL - SH
EASTERN NICTATOR - ASF
RED-CAPPED ROBIN CHAT – brief views at ASF
RED-TAILED ANTTHRUSH – even briefer views ASF!
EASTERN BEARDED SCRUB ROBIN - TB

BLACK CUCKOO-SHRIKE – females at ASF and TB
COMMON DRONGO - regular
