SYSTEMATIC LIST OF OBSERVATIONS

The taxonomic basis for the species account in this list is the fifth edition of *Birds of the World: A Checklist (Clements 2000)* and is supplemented with some recent taxonomic changes and/or taxonomic remarks. Species with asterix and in capitals are endemic species of Peru

TINAMOUS -TINAMIDAE

Great Tinamou (*Tinamou major*)

On 6 heard at Afluente and 8-08 heard along the Yurimaguas Road, Tarapoto.

Pale-browed Tinamou (Crypturellus transfasciatus)

On 1-08 heard down in the valley at Abra Porculla.

Ornate Tinamou (Nothoprocta ornate)

On 20-08 1 ex. Bosque Unchog.

Andean Tinamou (Nothoprocta pentlandii)

On 25-08 20+ near San Pedro de Caste, Upper Santa Eulalia. During our search for the Rufous-breasted Warbling-Finch we regularly flushed Andean Tinamou.

GREBES - PODICIPEDIDAE

White-tufted Grebe (Rollandia Rolland)

On 17-08 3exx.Lake Junin.

Silvery Grebe (podiceps occipitalis)

On 17-08 15 exx. Lake Junin.

* JUNIN GREBE (Podiceps taczanowskii)

On 17-08 2 exx. Lake Junin. The total population is estimated at less than 400 birds. Considered Critical.

PELICANS - PELICANIDE

Peruvian Pelican (*Pelecanus thagus*)

Up to 10 exx.along the coast near Puerto Huarmey and Huacho on 14 and 15-08.

BOOBIES - SULIDAE

Peruvian Booby (Sula variegate)

Rather common along the coast near Huacho on 14 and 15-08.

CORMORANTS - PHALICROCORACIDAE

Neotropic Cormorant (*Phalacrocorax brasilianus*)

Common along the coast near Huacho on 14 and 15-08.

Guanay Cormorant (Phalacrocorax bougainvillii)

On 15-08 7 exx.near El Paraiso.

Red-legged Cormorant (*Phalacrocorax gaimardi*)

On 14-08 2 exx.at Puerto Huarmey.

HERONS, EGRETS AND BITTERNS - ARDEIDAE

Great Egret (Casmorodius alba)

Scattered seen in the rice fields in the valleys along our route.

Little Blue Heron *Egretta caerulea*)

On 30-07 1 ex. near Olmos.

On 13-07 10+ in the ricefields between Cajamarca and the coast.

On 14-07 2 exx. near Huacho.

Snowy Egret (Egretta thula)

See Great Egret.

Cattle Egret (Bubulcus ibis)

Commonly observed, especially in the rice fields in the valleys.

Striated Heron (Butorides striatus)

On 31-07 1 ex.in a marsh near Olmos.

On 3-08 1 ex. near Morro de Calzada

On 9-08 2 exx.near Rioja.

On 10-08 1 ex. along the Rio Utcubamba near Leimebamba.

Black-crowned Night-Heron (Nycticorax nycticorax)

On 17-08 1 ex.in flight, Lake Junin.

Fasciated Tiger-Heron (Tigrisoma fasciatum)

On 10-08 2 exx. between Pomacochas to Leimebamba along the Rio Utcubamba...

On 14-08 20+ at coastal marsh near Trujillo. (Panam Hwy. km.450)

Puna Teal (Anas puna)

On 16-08 a few Marcopomacocha area.

On 17-08 40+ Lake Junin.

Cinnamon Teal (Anas cyanoptera)

On 14-08 a few at coastal marsh near Trujillo. (Panam Hwy. km.450)

On 15-08 common at El Paraiso near Huacho.

Andean Duck (Oxyura ferruginea)

On 16-07 4 exx. Marcopomacocha area.

Swallow-tailed Kite (*Elanoides forficatus*)

On 5-08 2 exx. Aguas Verdes.

On 7-08 1 ex. Morro de Calzada.

On 8-08 spectacular group of no less than 75 exx.migrating through the valley along the Yurimaguas Road, Tarapoto.

On 9-08 2 exx. Juan Guerra, near Tarapoto.

Plumbeous Kite (Ictinia plumbea)

On 6-08 1 ex. near Aguas Verdes.

On 9-08 1 ex. Juan Guerra, Tarapoto.

Cinereous Harriër (Circus cinereus)

On 14-08 1 ex. marshy area near Trujillo (Panam hwy km.450)

Plain-breasted Hawk (Accipiter ventralis)

On 4 and 6-08 single birds seen near Pomocochas and Afluente.

Gray-backed Hawk (Leucopternis occidentalis)

On 30-07 excellent views of a pair near Batan Grande. The species is rare in its restricted range in west Ecuador and North-west Peru.Considered "Endangered."

Savanna Hawk (Buteogallus meriodonalis)

On 30-07 5 exx. in the agriculture fields between Chiclayo and Batan Grande.

Harris' Hawk (Parabuteo unicinctus)

On 30-07 1 ex.Bosque de Pomac.

On 31-07 2 exx. Limon (Quebrada Frejollillo).

On 1-08 1 ex. Abra Porculla.

Black-chested Buzzard-Eagle (Geranoaetus melanoleucos)

On 1-08 2 exx. Abra Porculla.

On 4-08 1 ex. Abra Patricia.

On 15 and 16-08 2 exx. Santa Eulalia Valley. Also 1 on 25-08.

On 17-08 1 ex. between La Oroya – Huanuco.

Roadside Hawk (Buteo magnirostris)

19 exx. observed on 10 dates in Northern Peru.

All birds observed were of the pale fase.

On 25-08 2 exx. Lower Santa Eulalia Valley.

Peregrine Falcon (Falco peregrinus)

On 19-08 1 ex. Paty Trail.

GUANS, CHACHLACAS AND ALLIES - CRACIDAE

Speckled Chachalaca (Ortalis guttata)

Common around Morro de Calzada.

On 9-08 5 exx. seen Juan Guerra.

Andean Guan (Penelope montagnii)

On 4 and 5-08 1 ex. and on 9-08 2 exx. Afluente area.

On 18 and 19-08 3 resp. 2 exx. along the Paty Trail.

* WHITE-WINGED GUAN (Penelope albipennis)

On 31-07 excellent views of 2 families (total of 7 exx.) of this rare and restricted range bird at Quebrada Frejolillo (Limon). Considered critically endangered. We also found a (deserted?) nest with 3 eggs.

NEW WORLD QUAIL - ODONTOPHORIDAE

Rufous-breasted Wood-Quail (Odontophotus speciosus)

On 19-08 heard at the Paty Trail.

RAILS, GALLINULES AND COOTS -RALLIDAE

Uniform Crake (Amaurolimas concolor)

On 9-08 twice seen while crossing a track at site, 4 km.west of Rioja.

Spotted Rail (Pardirallus maculates)

On 31-07 1 ex. well observed in the scope at a small swamp near Olmos.

Blackish Rail (Pardirallis nigricans)

On 9-08 excellent views of 1 ex.at a swamp near our lunch site 4 km.west of Rioja. At least 3 more birds were heard.

Plumbeous Rail (Pardirallus sanguinolentus)

On 14-08 6 exx.at coastal swamp south of Trujillo.(Panam Hwy km.450)

Common Moorhen (Gallinula chloropus)

On 31-07 5 exx.at swamp near Olmos.

On 14 and 15-08 common in coastal areas.

Andean Coot (Fulica ardesiaca)

On 14-08 2 exx. south of Trujillo.

On 15-08 common El Paraiso and on 17-08 common Lake Junin.

Giant Coot (Fulica gigantean)

On 16-08 8 exx.Milloc/Marcopomacocha area.

OYSTERCATCHERS -HAEMATOPODIDAE

Blackish Oystercatcher (Haematopus ater)

On 14-08 6 exx.harbour of Huarmey.

American Oystercatcher (Haematopus palliates)

On 14-08 1 ex.beach of Huarmey.

AVOCETS - RECURVIROSTRIDAE

Black-necked Stilt (Himantopus mexicanus)

On 14-08 3 exx.south of Trujillo and 10 exx. at Huarmey.

On 15-08 10 exx.El Paraiso.

THICK-KNEES - BURHINIDAE

Peruvian Thick-knee (Burhinus superciliaris)

On 31-07 17 exx.in a dry riverbed along the track between Limon and the Panam Hwy.On 15-08 5 exx.along the entrance road of Lomas de Lachay.

PLOVERS - CHARADRIIDAE

Andean Lapwing (Vanellus resplendens)

On 11 and 12-08 up to 20 exx. between Leimebamba and Cajamarca.

Common around Lake Junin. Up to 6 exx. Bosque Unchoc.

Killdeer (Charadrius vociferus)

On 14-08 20+ Huarmey.

Semipalmated Plover (*Charadrius semipalmatus*)

On 15-08 2 exx.at El Paraiso.

Kentish Plover (*Charadrius alexandrinus*)

On 14-08 1 ex. near Trujillo (Panam Hwy km.450)

Diademed Sandpiper-Plover (*Phegornis mitchellii*)

One of the highlights of the trip. A most wanted and long-awaited species.

On 16-08 excellent views of 2 adult and 1 juv. bird at Marcopomacocha.

SANDPIPERS - SCOLOPACIDAE

Puna Snipe (Gallinago andina)

On 16-08 good views of 1 ex.at Marcopomacocha.

Andean Snipe (Gallinago jamesoni)

Heard on one early morning at Bosque Unchog.

Hudsonian Whimbrel (Numenius hudsonicus)

On 14-08 50+ at Huarmey.

On 15-08 common at El Paraiso.

Greater Yellowlegs (Tringa melanoleuca)

On 14-08 1 ex. south of Trujillo during a road side stop.(Panam Hwy km.450)

Lesser Yellowlegs (*Tringa flavipes*)

On 14-08 10 exx.south of Trujillo and 20+ at Huarmey.

On 15-08 20+ at El Paraiso.

Spotted Sandpiper (Actitis macularia)

On 10-08 1 ex. along Rio Utcubamba.

On 14-08 1 ex. Huarmey.

Ruddy Turnstone (Arenaria interpres)

On 14-08 8 exx.harbour of Huarmey.

Sanderling (Calidris alba)

On 14-08 2 exx.beach of Huarmey.

Semipalmated Sandpiper (Calidris pusilla)

On 14-08 3 exx. Huarmey.

On 15-08 40+ at El Paraiso.

Least Sandpiper (Calidris minutilla)

On 14-08 2 exx.south of Trujillo.(Panam Hwy km.450)

Baird's Sandpiper (Calidris bairdii)

On 14-08 15 exx. Huarmey.

On 15-08 30+ El Paraiso.

Ruff (*Philomachus pugnax*)

On 14-08 1 ex. Huarmey. According to Clement's this species is accidental to Peru.

New species for Juve.

Wilson's Phalarope (Phalaropus tricolour)

On 14-08 20 exx. harbour of Huarmey.

SEEDSNIPES -THINOCORIDAE

Gray-breasted Seedsnipe (Thinocorus orbignyianus)

On 16-08 30+ observed along the road to Marcopomacocha.

Least Seedsnipe (Thinocorus rumicivorus)

On 14-08 4 exx. south of Trujillo.

On 15-08 20+ Lomas de Lachay area.

GULLS AND TERNS -LARIDAE

Band-tailed Gull (*Larus belcheri*)

On 13-08 2 exx.near Trujillo.

On 14 and 15-08 20-30 exx. observed at Huarmey and El Paraiso.

Gray Gull (Larus modestus)

On 14-08 1000+ along the coast.Locally abundant.

On 15-08 common El Paraiso.

Kelp Gull (*Larus dominicanus*)

Less common than previous species along the coast.

Gray-headed Gull (Larus cirrocephalus)

On 13-08 3 exx. near Truiillo.

On 15-08 10+ at El Paraiso.

Andean Gull (Larus serranus)

On 16-08 2 exx.near Marcopomacocha.

On 17-08 20+ Lake Junin.

On 24-08 20+ along the central highway from Huanaco towards Lima.

Laughing Gull (*Larus atricilla*)

On 13-08 2 exx. near Trujillo.

Elegant Tern (Thalassus elegans)

On 14-08 6 exx.near Huarmey.

On 15-08 10+ at El Paraiso.

Peruvian Tern (Sterna lorata)

On 15-08 3 exx. at El Paraiso. Uncommon to rare along the Peruvian coast.

Black Skimmer (Rynchops niger)

On 15-08 100+ at El Paraiso.

PIGEONS - COLUMBIDAE

Scaled Pigeon (Columba speciosa)

On 6-08 1 ex. near Aguas Verdes.

Band-tailed Pigeon (Patagioenas fasciata)

Up to 10 exx.daily in the Abra Patricia area.

Single birds seen Paty Trail and Carpish Tunnel.

* PERUVIAN PIGEON (Patagioenas oenops)

On 11-08 20 exx. in the Maranon Valley, Balsas. Considered "Vulnerable"

Plumbeous Pigeon (Columba plumbea)

On 9-08 2 exx. Juan de Guerra.

Eared Dove (Zenaida auriculata)

Recorded on 11 days in Northern Peru and Central Peru.

Pacific Dove (Zenaida meloda)

Up to 20 exx. on 30 and 31-07 Batan Grande and at Quebrada Limon.

Small numbers observed in coastal areas of north Peru.

Ecuadorian Ground-Dove (Columbina buckleyi)

On 1-08 10 exx. Abra Porculla.

On 2-08 2 exx. at our lunch stop site along the Rio Utucubamba.

Croaking Ground-Dove (Columbina cruziana)

Common in North Peru.

Ruddy Ground-Dove (Columbina talpacoti)

On 7-08 2 exx. Morro de Calzada.

On 9-08 10 exx. near Tarapoto.

Blue Ground-Dove (Claravis pretiosa)

On 2-08 4 exx. Chirinos road near Tamborapa(Jaen)

On 7,8 and 9-08 up to 4 exx.daily in the Tarapoto area.

Bare-faced Ground-Dove (Metriopelia ceciliae)

On 15, 16 and 24-08 up to 20 exx.in the Santa Eulalia Valley.

Black-winged Ground-Dove (Metriopelia melanoptera)

On 16-08 3 exx. upper Santa Eulalia Valley.

White-tipped Dove (Leptotila verreauxi)

Almost daily observed in Northern Peru.(11 out of 16 days) from single birds up to 20 in the Marañon Valley.

White-throated Quail-Dove (Geotrygon frenata)

On 22-08 1 heard on the Paty Trail.

On 23-08 good views of 1 ex. walking in the open on the Paty Trail.

PARROTS - *PSITTACIDAE*

Scarlet-fronted Parakeet (Aratinga wagleri)

On 2-08 10+ near Jaen (Chirinos road near Tamborapa) and 50+ en route between Jaen and Pomacochas.

Champman's Parakeet (*Aratinga alticola*) split from Mitred P.(*A.mitrata*)

On 10-08 200+ near Leimebamba.

On 11-08 30+ near Leimebamba.

Red-masked Parakeet (Aratinga erythrogenys)

On 30-07 20 and on 31-07 up to 50 exx.at Quebrada Limon. We had good views of perched birds. Considered "near-threatened."

White-eyed Parakeet (Aratinga leucopthalmus)

On 4 and 5-08 10-30 exx.upper Abra Patricia.

Maroon-tailed Parakeet (Pyrrhura melanura)

On 8-08 2 exx. near Tarapoto.

On 9-08 2 exx.Juan Guerra.

Mountain Parakeet (Bolborhynchus aurifrons)

On 16-08 4 exx. Santa Eulalia.

Andean Parakeet (Bolborhynchus orbygnesius)

On 25-08 20 exx. Upper Santa Eulalia Valley.

Blue-winged Parrotlet (Forpus xanthopterygius)

On 6-08 50+ near Aguas Verdes.

Pacific Parrotlet (Forpus coelestis)

On 30 en 31-07 common (50+) at Quebrada Frejolillo (Limon).

On 1-08 6 exx.near Jaen.

Cobalt-winged Parakeet (Brotogeris cyanoptera)

On 9-08 100+ at Juan de Guerra, Tarapoto area.

Blue-headed Parrot (*Pionus menstruus*)

On 7 and 9-08 40 and 10 exx. at Morro de Calzada and Juan Guerra, respectively.

White-capped Parrot(*Pionus seniloides*)

split from **Speckle-faced P.**(*P.tumultuosus*).

On 3-08 30+ near Pomacochas and Abra Patricia.

On 18-08 2 exx. Carpish Tunnel.

CUCKOOS - CUCULIDAE

Hoatzin (Opisthocomus hoazin)

On 9-08 15 exx. along the rio at Juan Guerra. Tarapoto.

Squirrel Cuckoo (Piaya cayana)

A total of 9 exx.on 6 dates in Northern Peru.

Smooth-billed Ani (Crotophaga ani)

Locally common on the east side of Abra Patricia.

Groove-billed Ani (crotophaga sulcirostris)

Common throughout the trip in the dry, arid regions.

Note: We did not always bother to identify any Ani we observed.

OWLS - STRIGIDAE

Tropical Screech-Owl (Megascops choliba)

On 6-08 1 ex. calling in the garden of hotel La Ribera, Rioja.

Peruvian Screech-Owl (Megascops rocoratus)

On 30-07 1 ex.calling near the campsite at Quebrada Frejelillo (Limon).

Rufous-banded Owl (Strix albitarsus)

On 3-08 2 exx.calling Abra Patricia.

On 21 and 22-08 2 and 1 ex.calling at Bosque Unchog.1 ex.briefly seen.

Ferruginous Pygmy-Owl (Glaucidium brasilianum)

On 5-08 1 ex. heard near Afluente.

On 8-08 1 ex. heard near Tarapoto.

Peruvian Pygmy-Owl (Glaucidium peruanum)

On 30 and 31-07 2 exx. observed at Batan Grande and 1 ex. at Quebrada Frejelillo (Limon).

On 15-08 1 ex. at Santa Eulalia Valley.

Yungas Pygmy-Owl (Glaucidium bolivianum)

Daily heard during the day at Bosque Unchog. On 20-08 excellent views of 1 ex.

NIGHTJARS -*CAPRIMULGIDAE*

Band-winged Nightjar (Caprimulgus longirostris)

Op 1-08 1 ex. near Abra Porculla.

On 11-08 2 exx. Hacienda Limon.

Scrub Nightjar (*Caprimulgus anthonyi*)

On 30-07 1 ex.in broad daylight at Batan Grande.

On 31-07 1 ex.flushed at Quebrada Frejelillo (Limon).

Lyre-tailed Nightjar (Uropsalis lyra)

On 3-08 astonishing views of a very responsive male at Valle Hermosa, Abra Patricia. On 6-08 1 ex. heard near the restaurant at the Afluente bridge.

Swallow-tailed Nightjar (*Uropsalis segmenata*)

In the early morning of 11-08 we had 2 female type birds on the road near Leimebamba.

SWIFTS - APODIDAE

White-chested Swift (Cypseloides lemosi)

On 2 exx. Abra Patricia, rocky slope near the Ridge trail. Very rare in north-west Peru

White-collared Swift (Streptoprocne zonaris)

Up to 20 exx. observed in the Abra Patricia area.

On 11-08 200+ late afternoon near Balsas.

Pale-rumped Swift (Chaetura egregia)

Daily observed from Afluente – Aguas Verde – Rioja – Tarapoto.

On 8-08 50+ along the Yurimaguas Road, Tarapoto.

White-tipped Swift (Aeronautus montivagus)

On 1-08 a flock (10+) at Abra Porculla.

Up to 20 exx.on 3,4 and 5-08 in the Abra Patricia area.

Andean Swift (Aeronautus andecolus)

On 11-08 2 exx. Abra Barro Negro.

On 12-08 12 exx. between Hacienda Limon and Celendin.

Fork-tailed Palm-Swift (Reinarda squamata)

On 7-08 50+ Morro de Calzada.

On 8-08 10+ Tarapoto (tunnel area). On 9-08 20+ Tarapoto – Rioja.

HUMMINGBIRDS - TROCHILIDAE

Green Hermit (*Phaethornis guy*)

On 6-08 2 exx. Aguas Verdes.

* **KOEPCKE'S HERMIT** (*Phaethornis koepckeae*)

On 9-08 3 exx.along the Yurimagas Road, Tarapoto.

Uncommon species east slope of the Andes and considered "Near-Threatened."

Tawny-bellied Hermit (*Phaethornis syrrmatophorus*)

On 2-08 1 ex. Chirinos Road, Tamborapa.

Baron's Hermit (*Phaethornis baroni*)

The Long-tailed Hermit observed in a small gulley near Abra Porculla on 1-08 was this species. Split from **Western Long-tailed Hermit** (*P.longirostris*)

Grey-chinned Hermit (Phaethornis griseogularis griseogularis)

On 6-08 1 ex. of the nominate form at Afluente.

Grey-chinned (Porculla) Hermit (Phaethornis griseogularis porcullae)

On 1-08 common at Abra Porculla.

Possible split Porculla Hermit (Phaethornis porcullae)

Green-fronted Lancebill (Doryfera ludoviciae)

On 7-08 1 ex. at Morro de Calzada

Blue-fronted Lancebill (Doryfera johannae)

On 5-08 1 ex.near Afluente.

On 6-08 5 exx. Aguas Verdes area.

Regularly heard Carpish Tunnel and Paty Trail. After several brief views I finely obtained excellent and lengthly views of a foraging bird at close range on 23-08 along the Paty Trail.
