Location

Descriptions:

"Humacao West" is the area W of Route 3 off Route 925

"Humacao East" is the area E of Route 3 (main reserve area)

"El Yunque" is the area of Mt Britton Trail

"Guanica" is the trail/road across from the small HQ building at the end of Rte 334

"Susua" is the Susua Forest E of Sabana Grande

"Maricao 16.8" covers both the upper and lower trails at KM 16.8 on Rte 120

"Maricao HQ" is the road to the park HQ from Rte 120, and the trail that starts on the R side of the road just past the parking lot
