

Explanations to the species list

A = Barr Lake, Latham Reservoir and the area around, Longmont (Union Reservoir(Calkins Lake) and Little Gaynor Lake).

B = short for Barr Lake. **L** = short for Latham. **Lo** = short for Longmont.

B = Rocky Mountain National Park including Winter Park = **WP**.

C = Garden of the Gods (Colorado Springs) and Mesa Verde.

GG = short for Garden of the Gods. **MV** = short for Mesa Verde.

If there is neither a **GG** nor a **MV** behind the numbers, it means that the bird was seen at both places.

D = Kansas and Missouri. Rest areas in Kansas on Interstate 70 only. Forest Park in St. Louis plus Horshoe Lake State Park on the eastern side of Mississippi, which actually is in the state of Illinois. **K** = short for Kansas. **M** = short for Missouri.

If there is neither a **K** nor an **M** behind the number, it means that the bird was seen in both states.

E = Iowa and South Dakota. Along Interstate 29 in Iowa. Campground at De Soto N.W.R. Along Interstate 29 and 90 in S. Dakota. Badland National Park and Black Hills (Custer State Park). **I** = short for Iowa. **D** = short for S. Dakota. **B** = short for Badlands.

C = short for Custer State Park. If neither an **I** nor a **D** is behind the number, it means that the bird was seen in both states.

F = Wyoming, mainly Yellowstone National Park and Grand Teton National Park (Jackson Hole). Short stop at Story and lake outside Cody.

Y = short for Yellowstone. **T** = short for Grand Teton. **S** = short for Story. **C** = Cody.

If no letter is seen behind the numbers, it means that it is seen somewhere in Wyoming.

G = Utah (mainly Zion National Park in southwestern Utah) and Nevada (Mesquite).

Z = short for Zion. **N** = short for Nevada.

H = Grand Canyon from the northern rim and also along the road in Arizona.

GC = short for Grand Canyon.

I = Other places in Colorado including along the road. Mt. Evans, Evergreen, Aspen.

ME = short for Mt. Evans. **E** = short for Evergreen. **A** = short for Aspen. **R** = Rifle. If there is no letter behind it means the bird is seen along the road no specific place.

***** = Lifer

X = Birds not counted. Normally common in the area, often more than 10.

> = More than. **>10** = more than 10 birds.

? = I am not sure about this bird.
